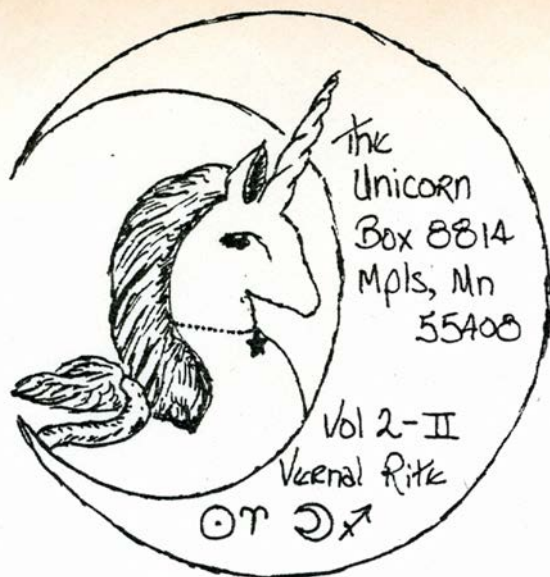

the Third Law of the Traditional Herbalist

"All creation is a balance of the four: air, fire, water, earth..."

And a remedy of the herbalist must be in balance..."



notes from an herbal... as regards an herbal amulet.

A simple amulet, but holding immense power, can be easily made and consecrated. The container a natural cloth bag, to be sealed with cord, or a leather pouch, sealed with thong... Sometimes an ornate case is made of metals, but few of us possess the skills of a jeweler.

Among the herbs associated with protection are angelica ♂, bay ♂, bitter-sweet ♀, elder ♀, horehound ♀, hyssop ♂, mistletoe ♂, (sometimes associated with ♀), red clover ♀, rue ♂, and, of course, Verberna ♀.

As you select your herbs and set them in a special container [I use a wooden box, upon which I set a candleholder], use a candle, and in the days as you prepare for the amulet, do your ritual sweeping & meditate upon your purpose. You may wish to add something personal, or a lodestone, a moonstone, or other gem or stone of your association... perhaps a sprinkle of sea salt for purification... and so forth. Select all the ingredients with utmost care & discrimination. Each herb should be understood, so that your preparation enhances your knowledge.

During the period of ritual sweeping, you should also prepare the bag. If cloth, you may wish to embroider an astrological symbol, a pentagram or other magical design, or a personal design. If leather, you may wish to do the same. For the most potent personal amulet, I draw a natal chart on a leather circle, which is then drawn into a bag by a leather thong, which is laced into the circle's outer edge.

All of the preparation should be done with intense concentration of purpose, with periods of meditation.

### The Third Law of Traditional Herbalists

"All creation is a balance of the four: air, fire, water, earth ....  
And a remedy of the herbalist must be in balance..."

Notes from the Herbal ... as regards an herbal amulet.

A simple amulet, but holding immense power, can be easily made and consecrated. The container a natural cloth bag, to be seal with cord, or a leather pouch, sealed with thong... Sometimes an ornate case is made of metals, but few of us possess the skills of a jeweler. Among the herbs associated with protection are angelica [sun Leo], bay [sun Leo], bittersweet [Mercury], elder [Venus], horehound [Mercury], hyssop [Moon], mistletoe [Sun], (sometimes associated with [Jupiter]), red clover [Mercury], Rue [Sun Leo], and, of course, Verbena [Venus]. As you select your herbs and set them in a special container. [I use a wooden box, upon which I set a candleholder], use a candle, and in the days as you prepare for the amulet, do you ritual sweeping & meditate upon your purpose. You may wish to add something personal, or a lodestone, a moonstone or other gem or stone of your association... perhaps a sprinkle of sea salt for purification... and so forth. Select all the ingredients with utmost care & discrimination. Each herb should be understood, so that your preparation enhances your knowledge.

During the period of ritual sweeping, you should also prepare the bag. If cloth, you may wish to embroider an astrological symbol, a pentagram or either magickal design, or a personal design. If leather, you may wish to do the same. For the most potent personal amulet, I draw a natal chart on a leather circle, which is then drawn into a bag by a leather thong, which is laced into the circle's outer edges.

All preparation should be done with intense concentration of purpose, with periods of meditation.
