

Symphony ready for new conductor

VALDOSTA — Valdosta Symphony Orchestra patrons will get a look at the new conductor again, for the first time.

Last September when Howard Hsu led the Valdosta Symphony Orchestra, he was the first of three candidates for the conductor's job. Next weekend, when he returns to Valdosta, Hsu (pronounced) "shoo") arrives as the new conductor of the Valdosta Symphony Orchestra.
