Stafford* of the other part: WITNESSETH that the said *Isabel Adams* for and in consideration of the sum of *Forty* Dollars, cash in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, hath bargained and sold, and doth by these presents, remise, release, and forever quit claim to the said *Eleazar J. Stafford*, his heirs and assigns, all the right, title, interest, claim or demand, the said *Isabel Adams* has or may have had in and to—
 Lot of land, numbers *All that tract of Land, situated in said State and County, known as the salt marsh (and fresh marsh, if any,) of the Crow Harbor tract, together with the Crow Harbor island, in said marsh, containing thirty-six hundred (on the north side of the Great Satilla River) (3600)* acres more or less, with all the rights, members and appurtenances to said *salt marsh tract of* land in any wise appertaining or belonging.

To HAVE AND TO HOLD the said lot of land to the said *Eleazar J. Stafford*, so that neither the said *Isabel Adams*, nor his heirs, nor any other person or persons claiming under him, shall at any time, by any ways or means, have claim, or demand, any right or title to the aforesaid lot of land or its appurtenances, or any part thereof.
