Entered into this the Twenty fourth day
day of February in the year Eighteen hundred
and ninety one between E. J. Stafford of the
said County of Camden of the first part. And
N. B. Stafford Sr. of the same place of the second
part. Witnesseth that the said E. J. Stafford for
and in consideration of the sum one thousand
one hundred and sixty five dollars to him
in hand paid by the said N. B. Stafford Sr.
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
doth hereby grant, bargain, sell, alien,
convey and confirm unto the said N. B. Staff-
ord Sr. his heirs, Executors, Administrators,
and assigns, Ninety five head of Stock
Cattle marked with "Smooth Crop and split
in one Ear". And "Swallowfork and underbit
in the other Ear" Branded with 96. Including
several tracts of Land more fully set forth
and described in the following Deeds to
wit. One tract containing one hundred and
twenty five (125) Acres more or less. And made
over to the said E. J. Stafford by S. S. Hargraves
on the tenth day of April 1878. And
recorded in Book D. Folio 178 on Aug.
30th 1882. The second deed describes a
tract of Land known as the "Dumelin
Hammock" tract containing one hundred
(100) Acres more or less. (See on page second)


Which was made over to Asa Stafford
Instead of E. J. Stafford as it should of been
Said tract was made over in two Deeds one
of which was made by Isabel Adams on the
9th day of March 1877. And recorded in Book
S Folios 207+208 Dec. 7th 1882. The third deed
made to Asa Stafford and made to the last
described tract of Land was made by Henry
J. Osborn on the twentieth day of March 1877
and recorded in book S Folios 208+209
Dec. 7th 1882. The fourth deed describes a
tract of Land known as the "Hardee and
Mullaley" tracts containing three hundred
(300) Acres more or less. Which was made
over to Asa Stafford instead of E. J. Stafford
as it should of been. Said tract was made
over in two Deed one of which was made by
Isabel Adams on the twelfth day of March
1877. And recorded in Book S. Folios 209+210
Dec. 8th 1882. The fifth Deed made to
Asa Stafford to the last described
tract of Land by Henry J. Osborn on the
thirteenth day of March 1878. And recorded
in Book S Folios 210+211. Dec. 8th 1882.
The sixth Deed describes a tract of Land
known as the "Salt and fresh Marsh
of the Crow Harbor" tract containing
Thirty six hundred 3600 Acres more
or less made over to (See page 3)

Eleazar J. Stafford by Isabel Adams on
 the fourth day of Dec. 1882. And record-
 ed in Book S Folio 505 Dec. 1st 1885
 The seventh Deed describes a tract of Land
 being a piece that was sold off from
 the tract that was granted to N. J. Patterson
 (More fully described in deed made by Robert
 Lang) and was sold to E. J. Stafford by George
 Peter in a deed made for one Hundred
 (100) Acres. on the fourth day of May 1883
 and recorded in Book III Folios 197 & 198
 Nov. 29th 1890. The Eight Deed describes a tract
 of Land being the remaining part of the
 tract that was granted to N. J. Patterson
 on the 16th day of Dec. 1859. and was made
 over to E. J. Stafford by Robert Lang Admin-
 istrator on the Estate George Peters for Two
 Hundred (200) Acres more or less on the
 19th. day of May 1887. and recorded in
 Book III Folios 200 & 201. Nov. 29th 1890. The
 Ninth Deed describes a tract of Land known as
 the "Crow Harbor" or a tract that was granted
 James Finley on the 29th. day of April 1787.
 For 5,950 Acres. and made over to E. J.
 Stafford by Fannie M. & Isabel Adams as
 the remaining interest in the "Crow Harbor" tract
 on the third day of April 1889. and recorded
 in Book II Folio 538. on 22nd Nov. 1889.
 The tenth being a grant. (see page 4)

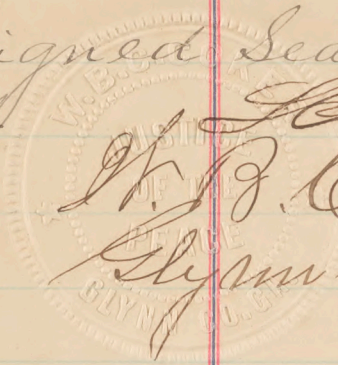

B. Stafford Sr. his heirs, Executors, Administrators and assigns in fee simple and the said E. J. Stafford the said bargained premises unto the said N. B. Stafford Sr. his heirs, Executors, Administrators, and assigns against the said E. J. Stafford. his heirs, Executors, and Administrators and assigns, and against all and every other person - shall and will warrant and forever defend (see page fifth)
