with all and singular the rights, members and appurtenances thereof whatsoever, to the said tract or parcel of land, belonging or in any wise appertaining; and also, all the estate, right, title, interest, claim and demand of the State aforesaid, of, in, to, or out of the same: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract or parcel of Land, and all and singular the premises aforesaid, with their and every of their rights, members and appurtenances unto the said *James W. Stafford* his

heirs and assigns, to *his* and their own proper use and behoof forever, in fee simple.
