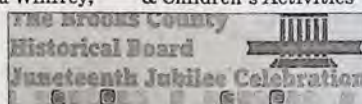

In 1961, I, Dr. Horne, was blessed to accompany my parents, Mr. & Mrs. Hilton Horne Sr. to tour the White House and its Interior, a beautiful monastery

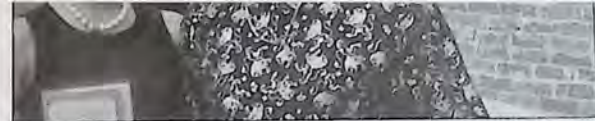

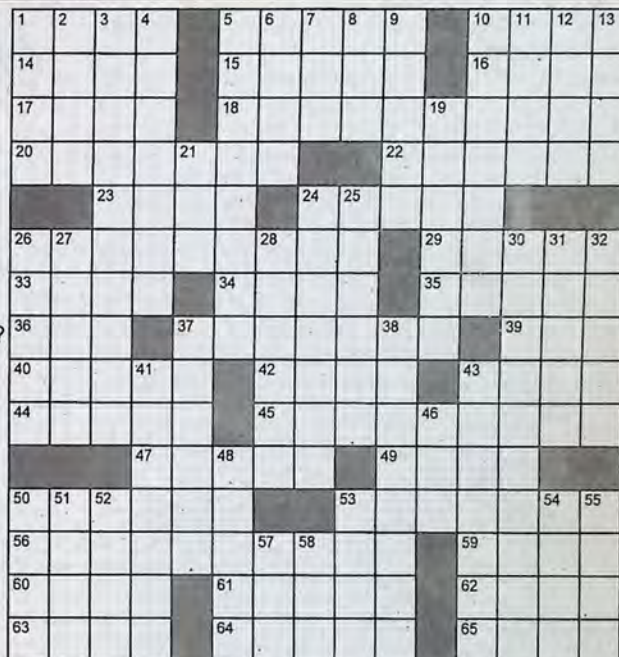
