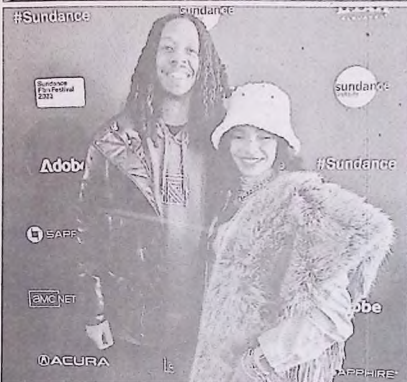
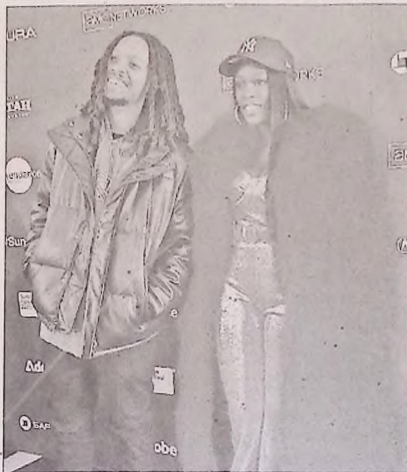

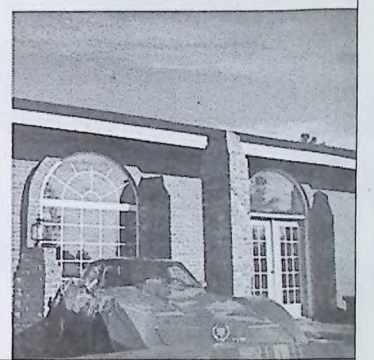
I was fortunate and blessed to receive a plethora of cultural

The Memorable 'Winfrey Hug'

Friday July 8, 2022 was a day of my personal reflection and a day of remembrance that honors the life sojourn of a special gentleman - a charismatic man whose good-natured comport, friendly conversational interchange and cordial bearing embraced us the moment I, Dr. Horne, and Mrs. Elizabeth Howell Tiller were privileged to be in Mr. Vernon Winfrey's gracious company on December 20, 2019 as we entered the famed "Winfrey Barbershop."

Mrs. Judy ("Miss Judy") Winfrey, my godmother and her daughter, Ms. Karla Winfrey, a Co-Mentor, Co-Author and Co-Producer on our conjoint mentoring and educational projects, which actually had origins in our small Quitman township with local, area and national distribution, disclosed to me and Mrs. Tiller ("Miss T") in December 2019 that whenever we had convenient occasion to be in Nashville, we could perhaps make the "Winfrey Barbershop" visit.

I had just, in the previous day, accompanied Mrs. Tiller, in the capacity of serving as her Internal Medicine Physician, to a fellow Physician Colleague in our Manhattan, NYC Annual Consultation, and we had made the intermittent visit to Nashville before Mrs. Tiller returned to the comfort and familiarity of her Middle Tennessee thousand acre-Century Farm Estate - where deer roam ubiquitously along with replete wildlife of myriad species.

In fact, the commonality of mutual appreciation for the earth - for the farm - between Mr. Vernon and "Miss T" was one of the memorable highlights of their discussion during that visit. Mr. Vernon recalled and recounted his farm experiences in Mississippi earlier in his life and "Miss T" shared some of her Tennessee childhood and contemporary love of "country land" experiences with Mr. Winfrey that memorable day. They both also spoke of Mr. Winfrey's sixteen years of lengthy and significant political service in the Nashville

Metropolitan Council and "Miss T's" then-elected official political posture in her native Perry County as the first and only elected female Superintendent of Schools for eight years in the 1980s. I listened intently and jubilantly as they both shared some of their varying yet similar political hilarities during their respective service to the public - both being political trailblazers during the conservatism of those times!

I, Dr. Horne, and "Miss T" watched this octogenarian marvel of a gentleman manifest his barber skill as he weaved his barber skill "magic" and haircut expertise on one of his close friends in the Winfrey Barber Chair - who also shared in the discussion because all of us had the privilege of knowing some of the legendary impactful figures which had contributed greatly to progressive positive changes in Nashville life such as Dr. Edward Perry Crump MD, Dr. Lloyd Elam MD and Dr. Otis Floyd. We three recounted and gave reverent reflection to knowing and appreciating these and other Nashville "Movers & Shakers."

I savor that memorable encounter with Mr. Vernon Winfrey which can be best recapitulated in my exact written words in revering Mr. Vernon Winfrey then and forever now, in my coverage QFP Edition, January 1, 2020 Quitman Free Press "Doc's Special Messages" Column, entitled "The Veritably Gracious Mr. Winfrey."

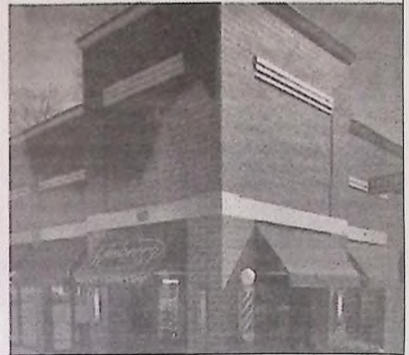
I, Dr. R. Marie Horne MD wrote and partially recount excerpts in the QFP Edition, January 1, 2020 in my own words: "Mr. Winfrey shared with us a review of photos of the Singing Trio [in Mr. Winfrey's reference to the "Barbershop Boys"] in entertaining mode and clad in their splendidly dapper attire during their most recent services to a local church pastored by the wife of one of the long-standing barbershop patrons of Mr. Winfrey's whom we also happened to meet during our special and memorable visit along with another distinguished

There was one particular picture of the Barbers and their eclectic assortment of Sixties Era clippers which prompted my momentary reminiscence of and reflection upon my own Mother's collectible clippers and other cosmetology implements displayed in times past in her Horne's Beauty Salon in Quitman. I have experienced the blessing of knowing, respecting and treasuring my godmother, Mrs. Judy Winfrey since 1987 and she assured me that when I did have occasion to meet Mr. Vernon Winfrey, I would be impressed that he was such a great person - perhaps one Sunday, after Church attendance during one of my visits to her home for dinner or at his Barbershop,

Mrs. Judy Winfrey was profoundly accurate and sagaciously revelatory and Mrs. Tiller agrees that Mr. Winfrey is a human treasure of a gentleman, with noteworthy humility, engaging sincerity and a gregariously positive nature that dispels austerity and embraces human fellowship. Mr. Winfrey's famous, phenomenal, iconic daughter of global media acclaim and superlative accomplishment, Ms. Oprah Winfrey, certainly reflects her father's inculcation of extraordinary values in her rearing and parental tutelage! The riveting conversation and delightful encounter with Mr. Winfrey leaves an indelible impression in our hearts, minds and souls as his soul is gentle and thus establishing a feeling of agape connectivity and camaraderie with him, is inevitable. 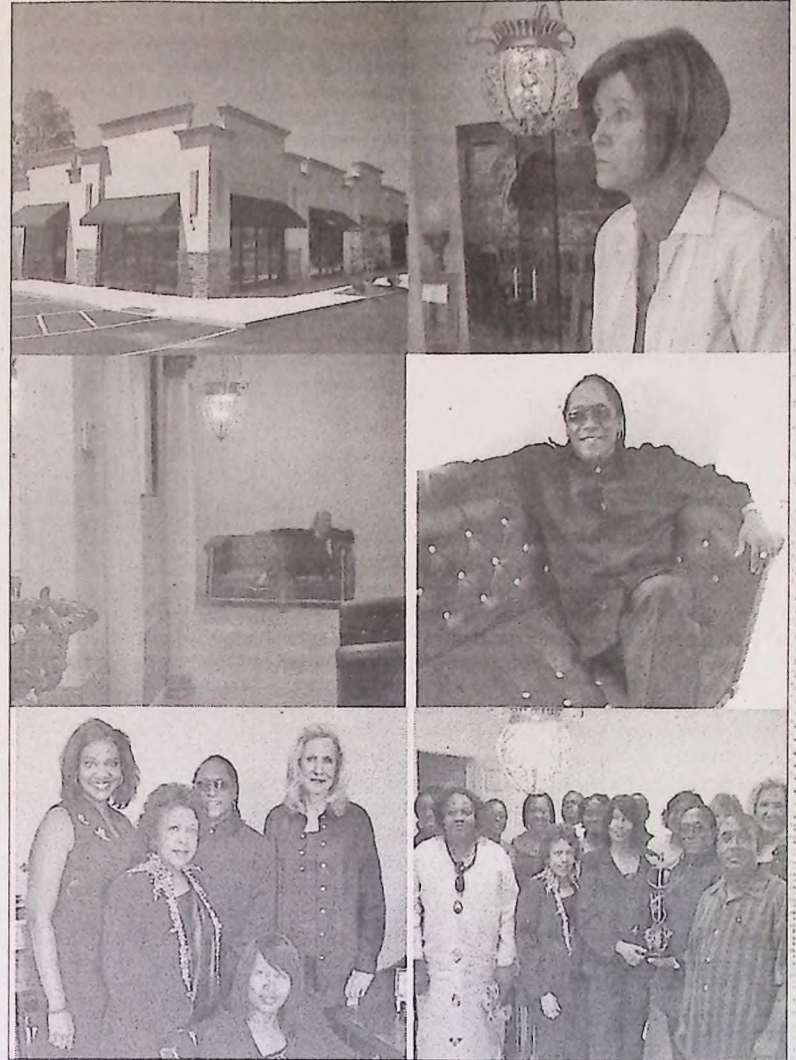
Recently, I have given much reflection to the various practice venues in which I avail patient care, one of which is reflected and representative in this coverage.

Tribute to a Lady of Honor



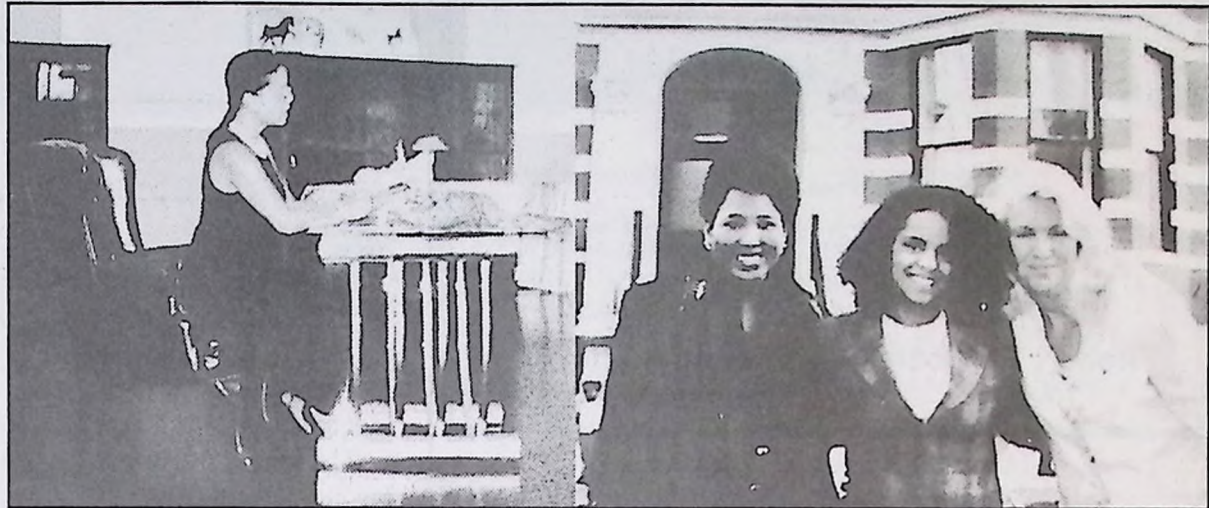
