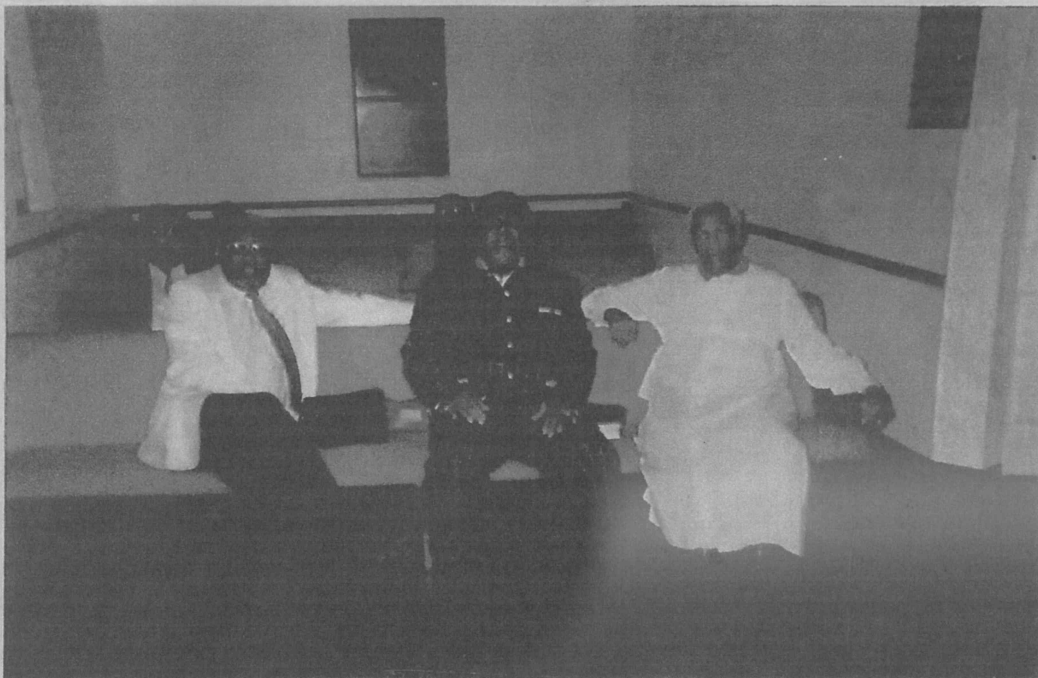

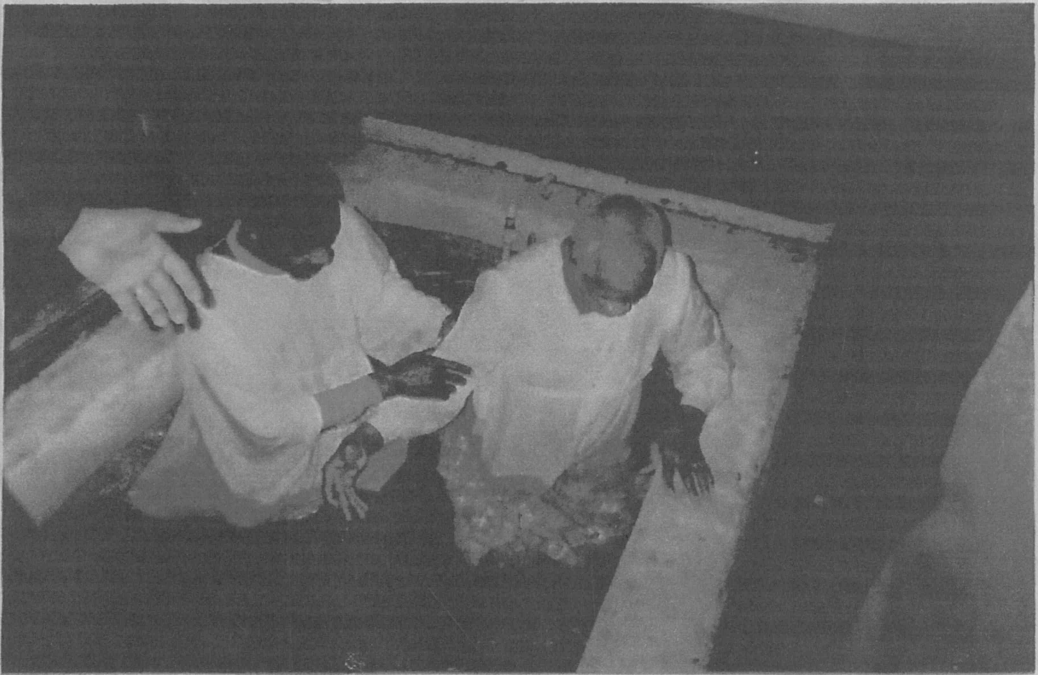

Reverends L. B. Robinson, Bernard Sales, W. R. Jenkins as they await baptism service.

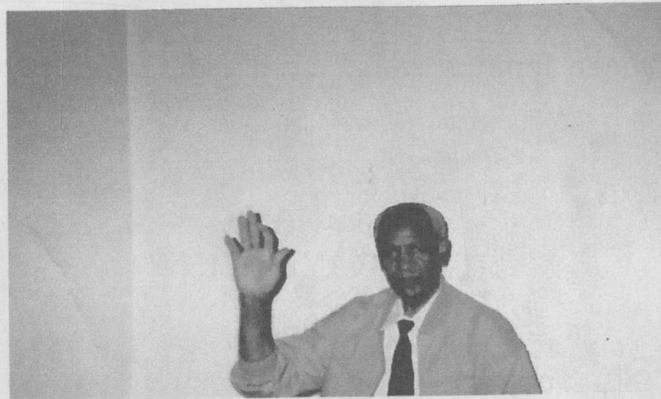

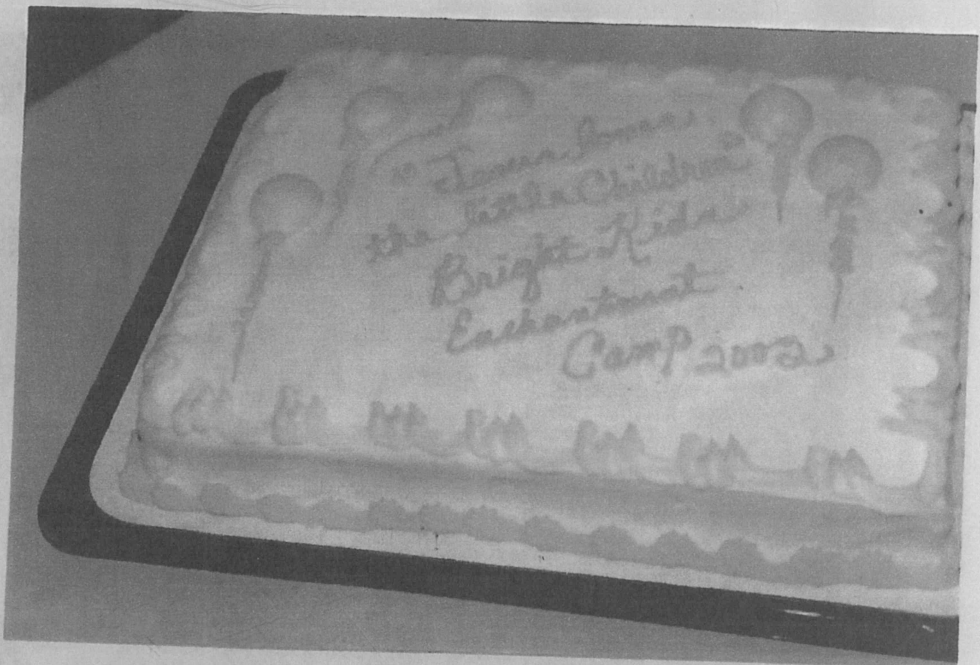

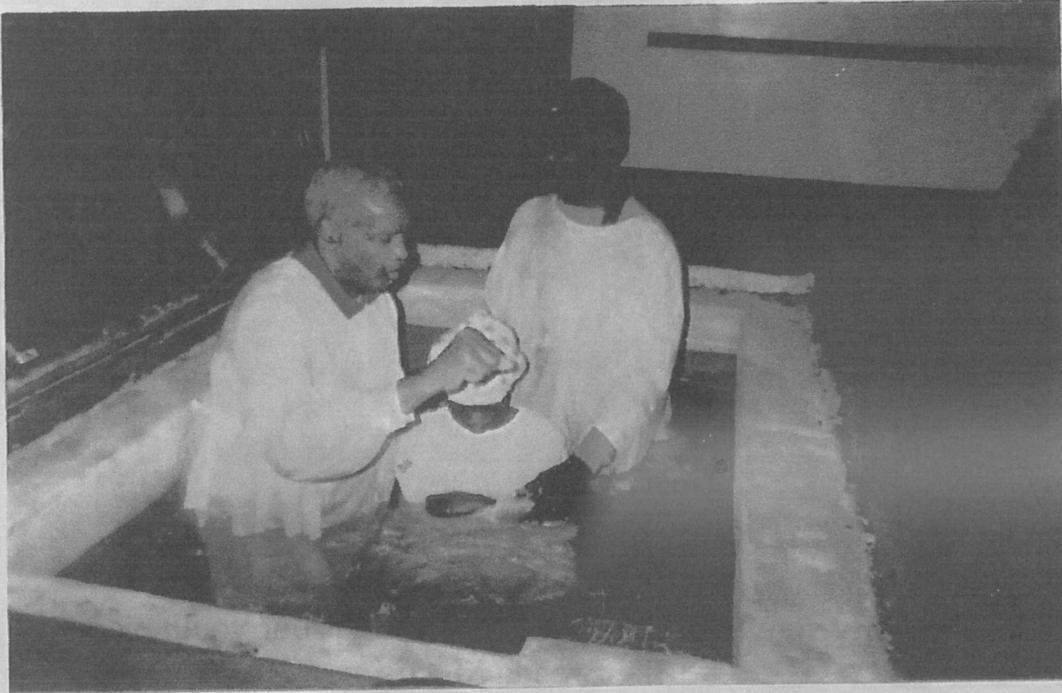

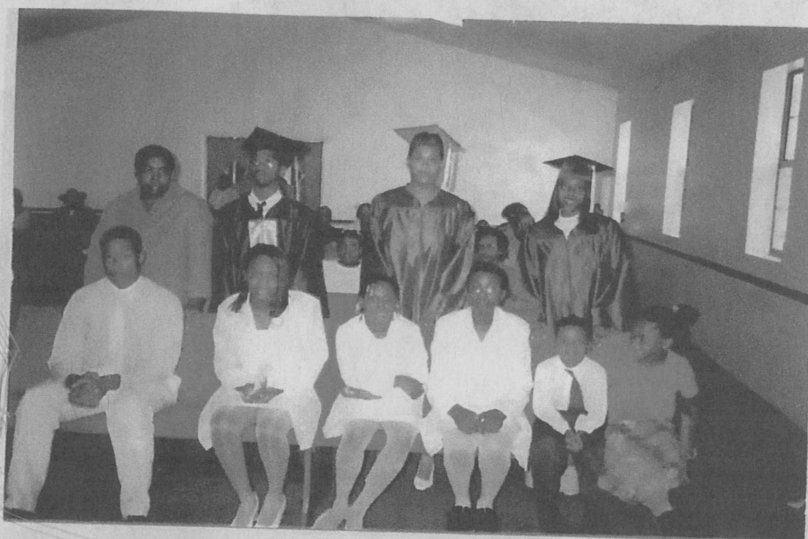
