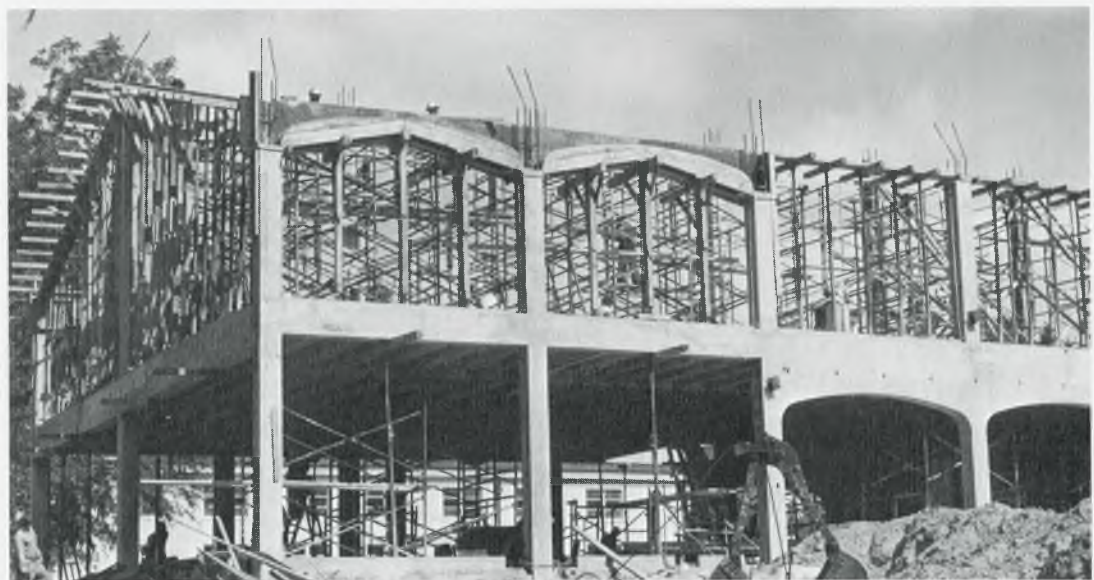

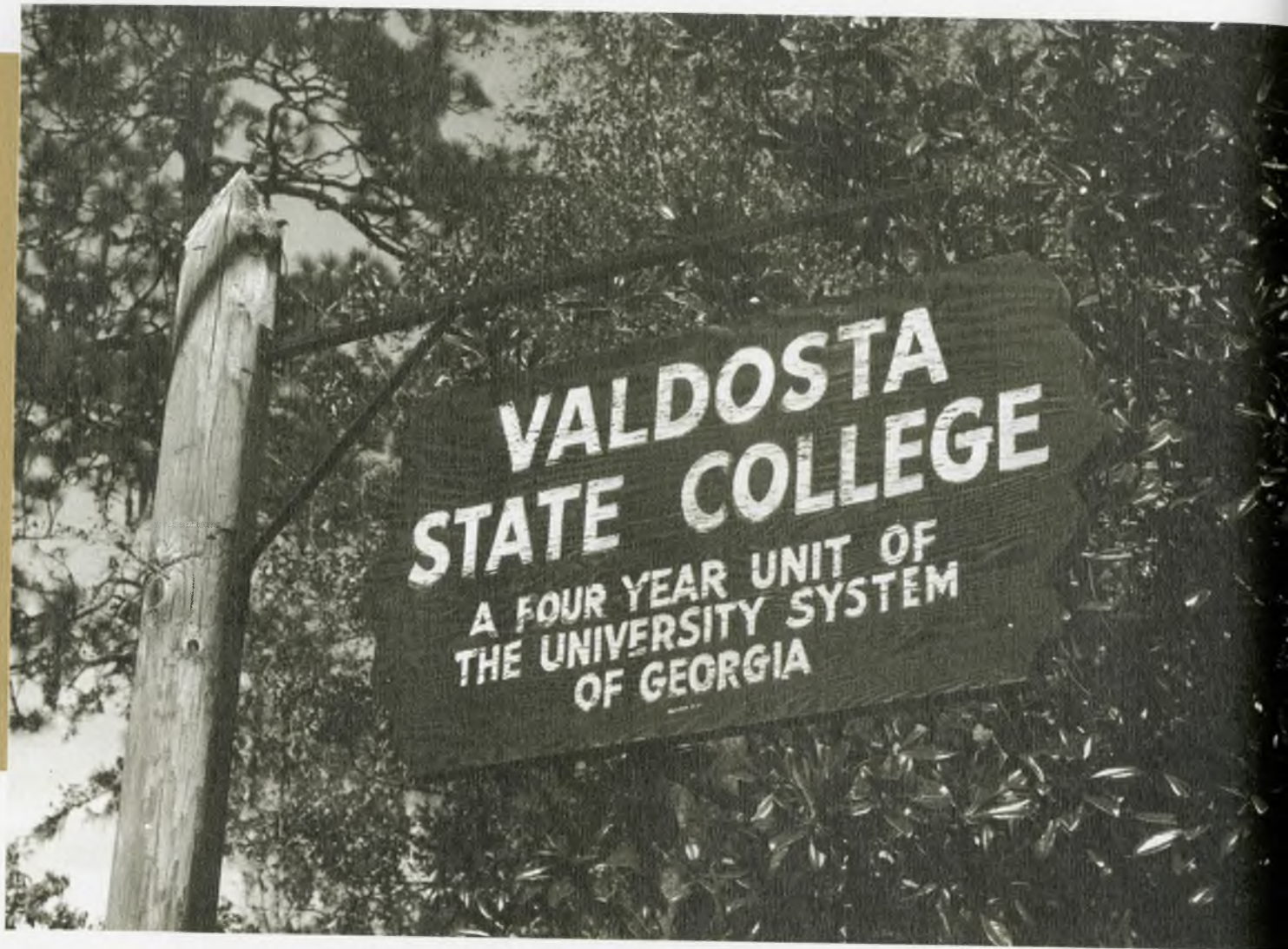

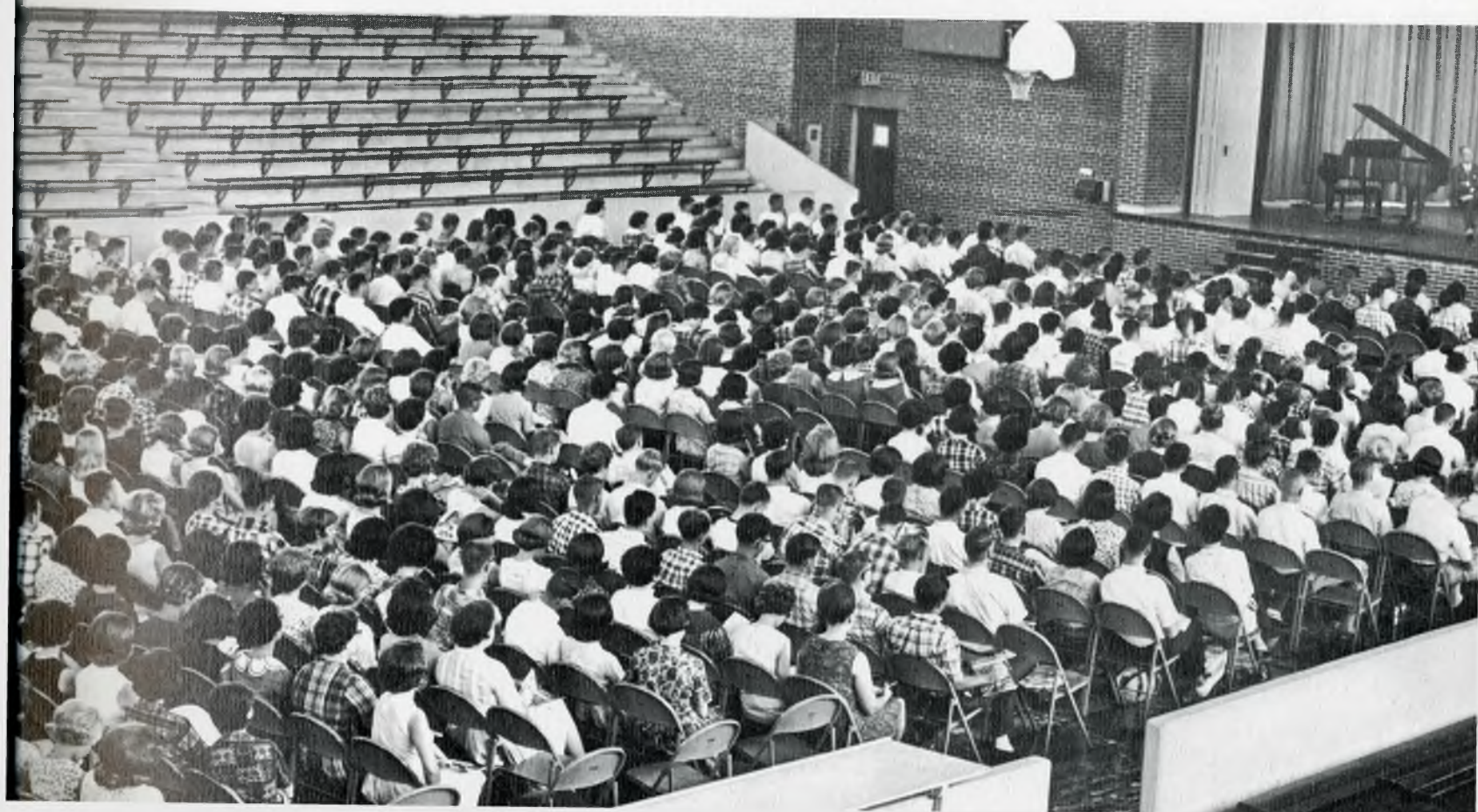


Preceding Rat Week and during the freshmen's first week at V.S.C., many facets of a new life hold the interest of each student every moment of the day.

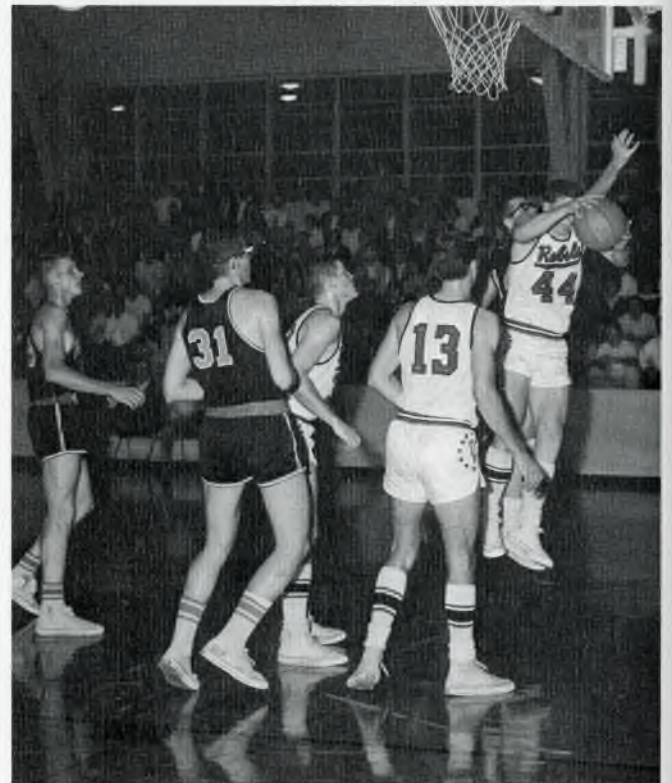
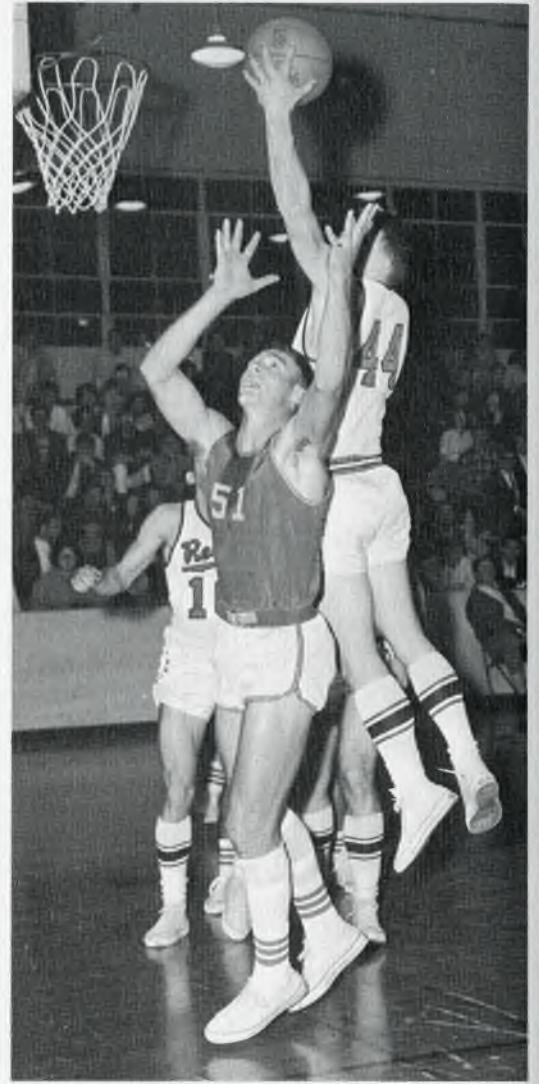
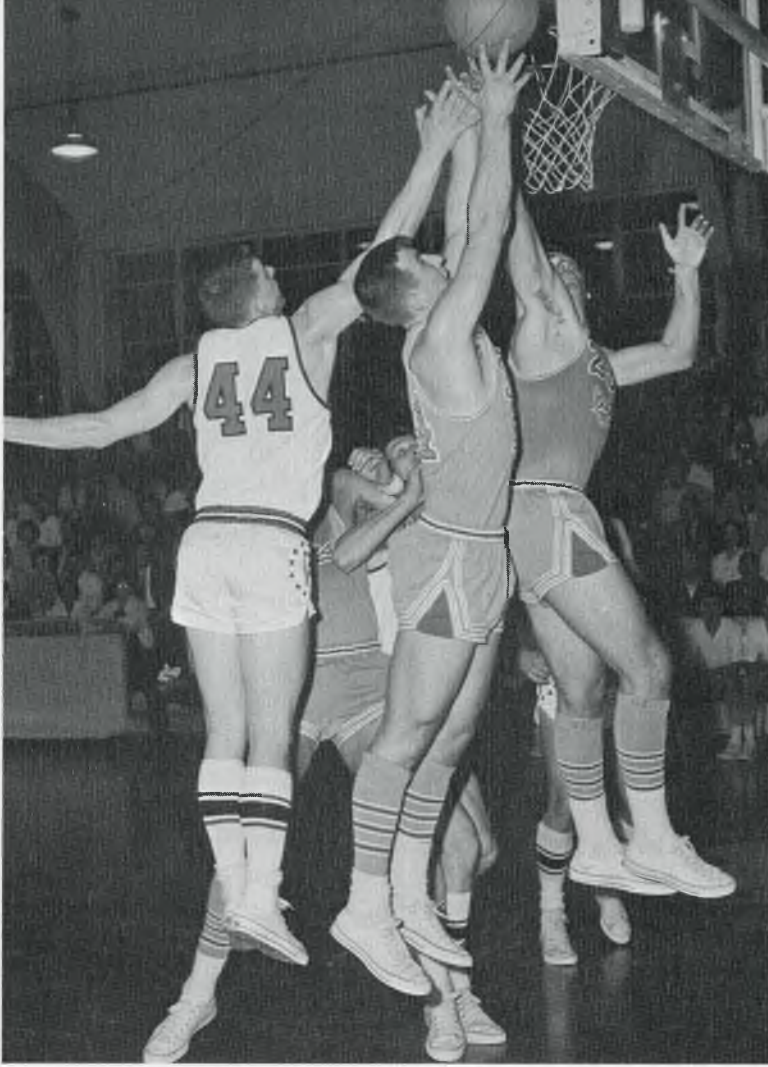


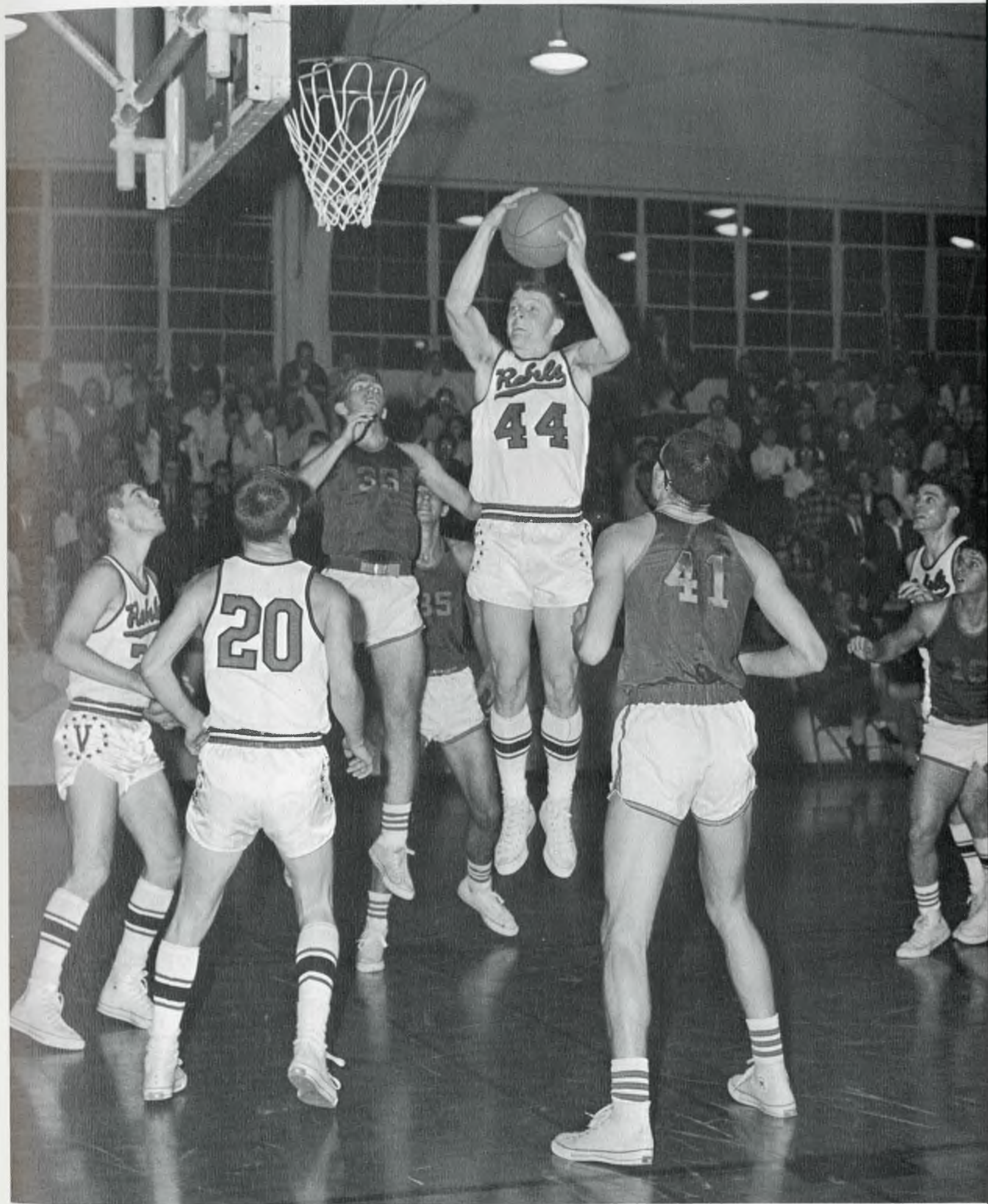
President's Reception

Freshman Orientation was brought to a close with the President's Reception. Here the students meet faculty members and also meet more fellow classmates.

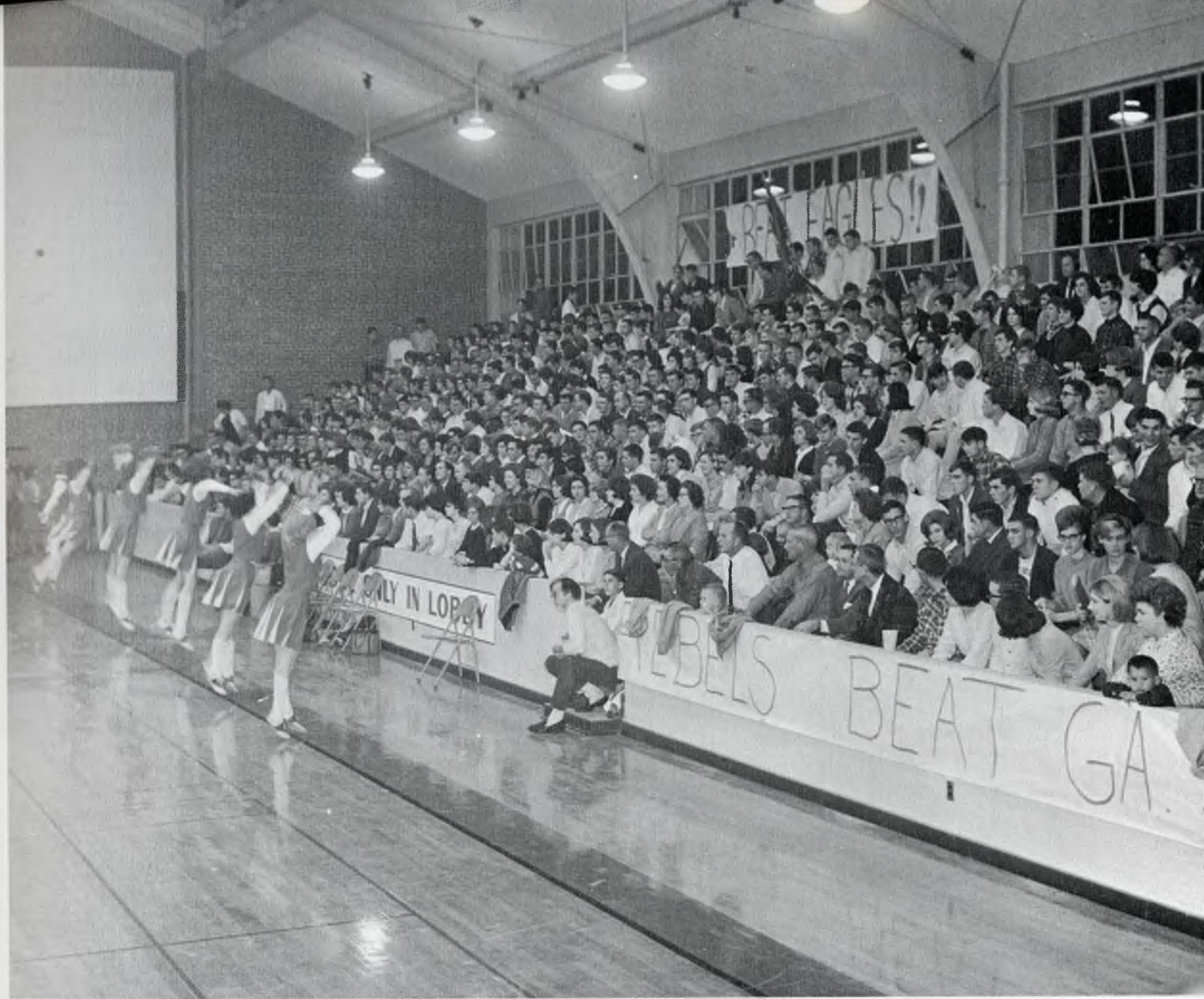


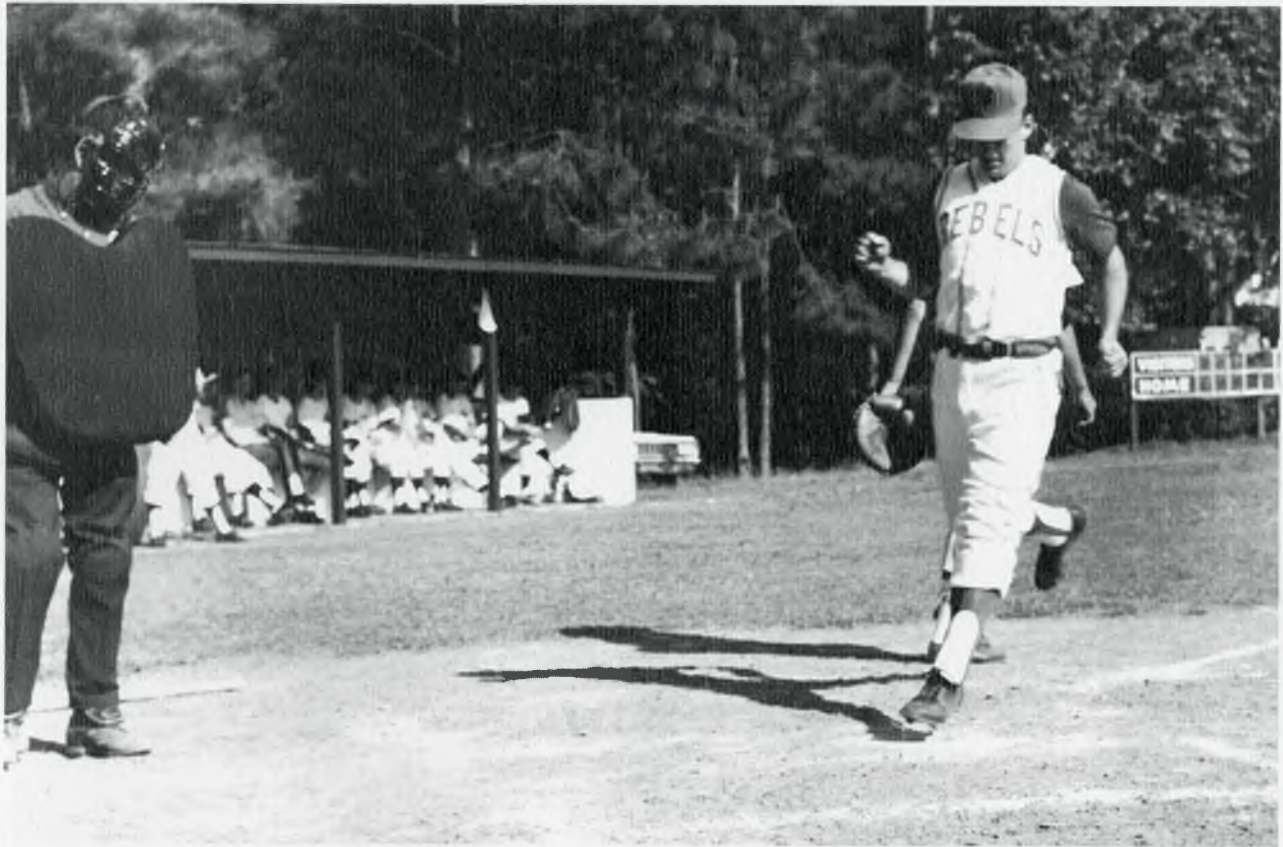


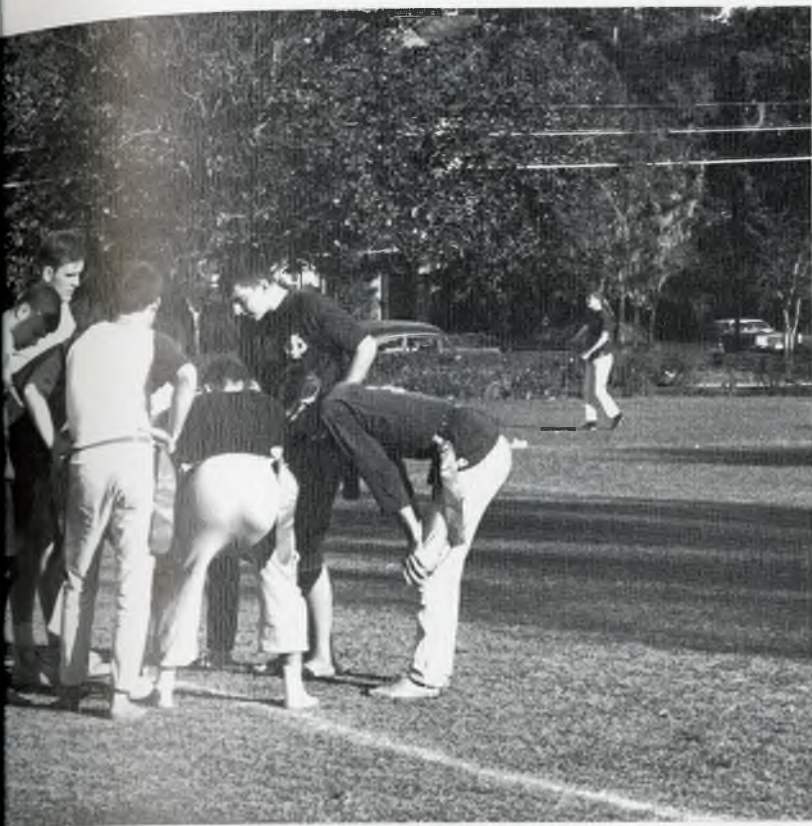


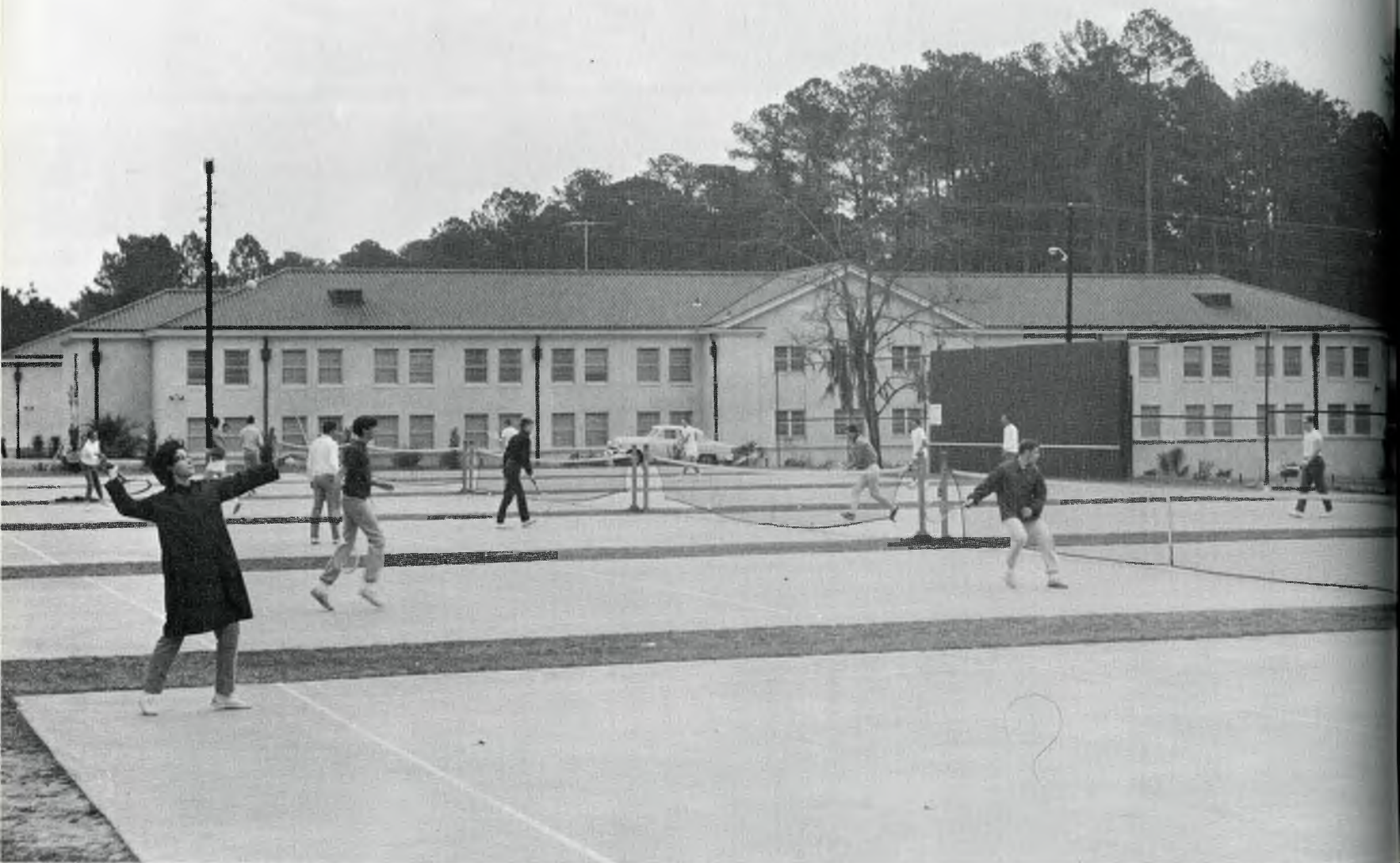


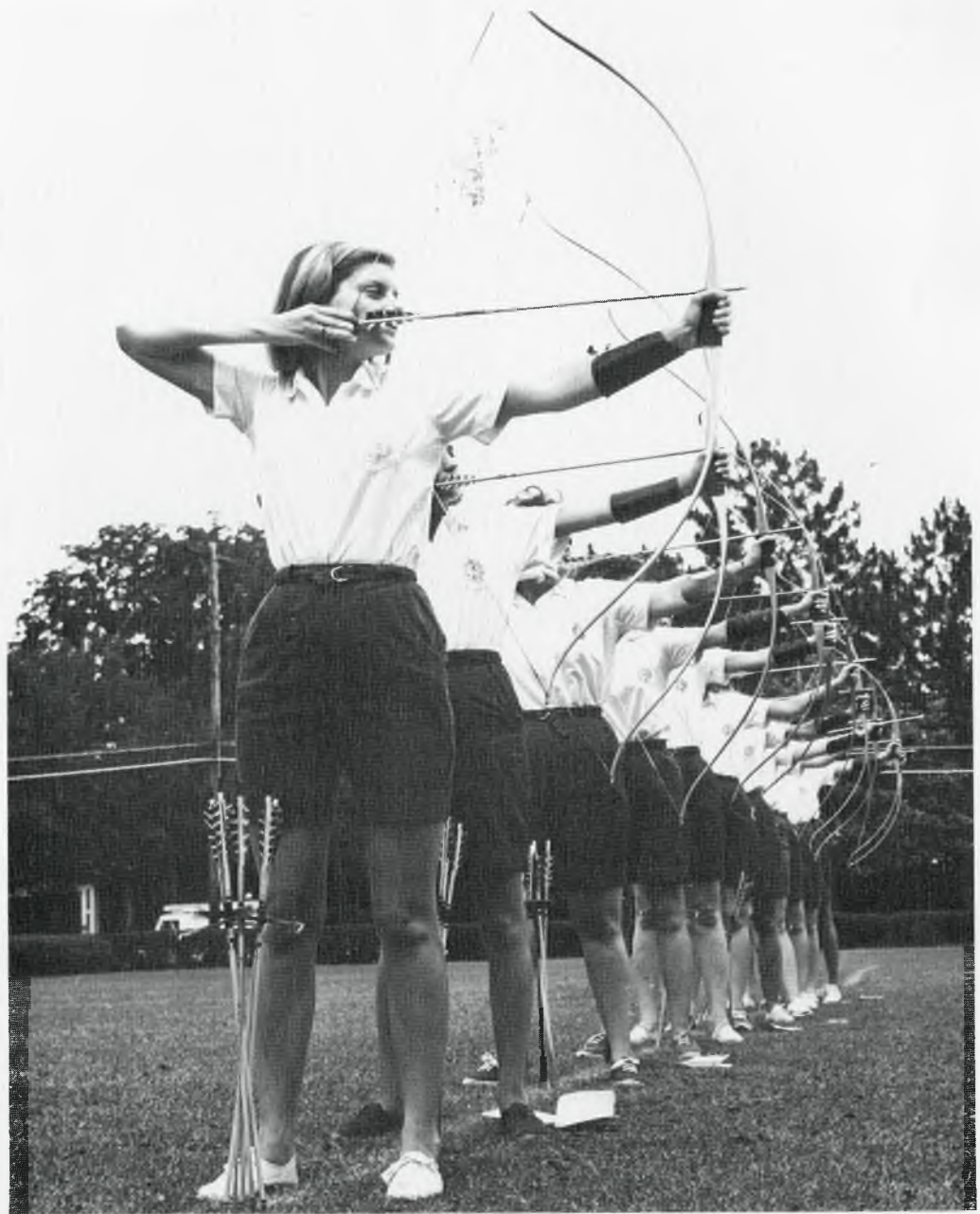
