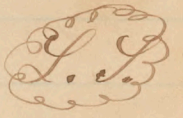


Georgia, Camden County. Personally appeared, Isabel Adams, of said State and county, who, on oath, deposes and says, that, a few years ago, she executed a deed, (said deed not being now before the said Isabel Adams, and the date of said deed not being now remembered,) of a portion of the Crow Harbor tract, situated in said state and county, (said Crow Harbor tract containing acres,) to a person, now living in Hazard's Neck of said county, known as Asa J. Stafford, the son of Nathaniel B. Stafford, of said Neck; that said Nat. B. Stafford requested that said deed should be made out in the name of Asa J. Stafford, (by which name the said Asa was usually known and called,); that the name, Asa J. Stafford is an abbreviation, instead of the name of Eleazer or Eleazar J. Stafford, the real name of the said Asa; that said name of Asa is a misnomer and a mistake; that said deed should have been made out in the name of Eleazer or Eleazar J. Stafford, the real name of the true grantee of said deed and portion of land of said Crow Harbor tract; also, that Asa J. Stafford and Eleazer or Eleazar J. Stafford are one and the same person, referred to in said deed: Wherefore, the said Isabel Adams makes this affidavit, for the purpose of explaining and correcting

said misnomer. Witness the hand and
