Covington, his heirs and assigns, his one half undivided interest in all of that tract, parcel or lot of land lying and being in the County of Camden, State of Georgia, containing three hundred acres more or less, and more particularly described as all that portion of a tract of land granted to Willis Lary conveyed on the twenty seventh day of February 1833 in compliance with a warrant dated February fourth 1833 lying west of old post Road from Burchs Fort to Barrington Ferry - (This said three hundred acres being a part of the original tract of five hundred acres)
