of the other part: WITNESSETH, that the said Henry J. Osborne,

for and in consideration of the sum of One Hundred Dollars,  
in hand paid, at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents,  
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath granted, bargained, sold, aliened, conveyed  
and confirmed, and by these presents doth grant, bargain, sell, alien, convey and confirm unto the  
said Asa Stafford, his

heirs and assigns, all those tracts or parcels of Land,  
situated in the County of Laurens, State  
of Georgia, being parts of the Crow Har-  
bor Tract, on the north side of the Great  
Satilla River, in said county of Laurens,  
and known as the Harder and Mulkey  
Tracts, containing, taken together, three  
hundred acres, more or less, said tracts,  
taken together, being bounded on the  
east by the Tumlin Haucock Tract,  
on the south by the Crow Harbor Marsh,  
on the west by lands formerly belonging  
to Calvin Wilson and now believed to  
belong to John M. Tison, and on the  
north by lands believed to belong to  
Nathaniel B. Stafford and others.

unto the said *Asa Stafforod, his* heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, against the said *Henry J. Osborne*,  
*his* heirs, executors and administrators, and against all and every  
other person or persons, shall and will warrant and forever defend by virtue of these presents.
