Stafford of the same place of the other part witnesseth that the said Isabel & Fannie M. Adams for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty five Dollars to them in hand paid by the said E. J. Stafford the receipt whereof is hereby Acknowledged doth hereby release, grant, sell and quit Claim unto the said E. J. Stafford, his heirs and assigns all all that tract of Land in the County aforesaid. Lying on the North side of the great Satilla river in Hazard's Neck known as the Crow Harbor tract or a tract that was granted to James Finley on the 29 day of April 1788. For 5,950 and more fully described in a plat made by Luther Martin Excepting and respecting any Deed heretofore made by us or F. M. Adams to any other party or parties in the said tract of Land. This Deed is made for the purpose

of Conveying all of the remaining
Interest we have in the Crow Harbor
tract of Land (and also to correct a
misnomer of Asa Stafford) which was
intended to be conveyed in Three Deeds
made several years ago at different ^{x times} by
the said Isabel Adams. two of said
Deeds were made to Asa Stafford instead
of E. J. Stafford as it should of been

To have and to hold said bargained pr
emises excepting as above described with
all the privileges thereto appertaining to
the said E. J. Stafford his heirs and assigns
So that neither the said Isabel
Fannie M. Adams their heirs nor any
person or persons claiming under
them shall at any time hereafter have
claim or demand any right or title to
the aforesaid premises or any part or
parcell thereof. Except as above described
