Camden County } This the fourth Day  
of December Eighteen Hundred and Sixty between  
J. A. Peoples Sheriff of the County  
afore said of the one part and W. Crawford  
of the same place of the  
other part witnesseth that where as  
said Sheriff did lately seize and  
levy upon a certain Tract of Land  
" (Notice of said Levy Having been  
given to the Tenant in possession " Situate  
Lying and being in the County afore said  
known and distinguished as the McIntosh  
Tract containing Three Hundred and Fifty  
Acres more or less " Lying in Hadzard. Sec  
Bound North by Joseph Hulls Lands  
and vacant Land west by Sampadocia  
Tract and Lands of G. Keedick. South  
by Sampadocia Tract and vacant Lands  
East by vacant Lands and Salina Tract  
" (as the property of Alexander Campbell  
by virtue of a writ of Fieri Facias  
Issued from the Superior Court of  
Glynn County of said State in Favor  
of the Commercial Bank of Brunswick  
Against said Alexander Campbell and after  
publicly Advertising said Tract of  
Land agreeably to Law said Sheriff  
did put up and expose the same

Sheriff Hath Granted bargained  
 and sold and by these presents both  
 Grant bargain and sell so far as the  
 office of Sheriff authorizes him.  
 "Unto him the said ~~Wm~~ Crawford  
 his heirs and assigns all the right  
 title and interest of the said Alexander  
 Campbell in said lot of land of  
 which the said Alexander Campbell  
 was seized and possessed as aforesaid  
 "with all the rights members and  
 appertinances there unto belonging or  
 in any wise appertaining to his  
 their own proper use benefit and behoof  
 forever. In witness whereof the said

 hath hereunto set his hand and

 above written
