& assigns all that tract or parcel of Land  
situated lying and being in the county &  
State aforesaid containing one Hundred &  
ninety four acres more or less bounded  
on one side by Aaron Stricklands lands & all  
other sides by vacant lands to have and  
to hold said tract or parcel of lands unto  
said N. B. Stafford his heirs and assigns together  
with all & singular the members and apperten-  
ances thereof to the same in any manner belong-  
ing to his or their proper use benefit &  
behoof forever in fee simple & the said  
Francis Reddick will warrant & defend  
the said Lands from him self & his heirs  
& from no other person in witness whereof  
the said Francis Reddick hath hereunto  
set his hand & seal the day and year
