J. Slaff having such shape, form and marks as appear by a plat of the same hereunto annexed, together mith all and singular the rights, members and appurteances thereof whatsoever, to the said tract or parcel of land, belonging, or in anywise appertaining; and also all the estate, right, title, interest, claim and demand of the State aforesaid, of, in, to, or out of the same; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract or parcel of land, and all and singular the premises aforesaid, with their and every of their rights, members and appurtenances Secretary Executive Department unto the said 1/10 heirs and assigns to behoof forever in fee simple.
