STATE OF GEORGIA.

By his Excellency *Peter Early* — — — Governor  
and Commander in Chief of the army and navy of this state, and  
of the Militia thereof.

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING:

KNOW YE, That in pursuance of the Act for opening the Land Office, and by virtue of  
the powers in me vested, I have given and granted, and by these presents, in the name and  
behalf of the said state, DO give and grant unto *Williams Stafford his*

— — — — — heirs and  
assigns forever, all that tract, or parcel of land, containing *Two Hundred*  
— — — — — acres, situate, lying and being in the  
county of *Wayne* — — — — — in the said state, and butting and

bounding *N.W. by Williams' & vacant N.E. by Williams*  
*S.E. by William Creels & S.W. by Vacant Land*

having such shape, form and marks, as appear by a plat of the same here into annexed; to-  
gether with all and singular the rights, members, and appurtenances thereof, whatsoever, to  
the said tract, or parcel of land belonging, or in any wise appertaining, and also all the estate,  
right, title, interest, claim and demand of the state aforesaid, of, in, to or out of the same: TO  
HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract, or parcel of land, and all and singular the premises  
aforesaid, with their, and every of their rights members and appurtenances, unto the said

*William Stafford his* — — — heirs and assigns, to *have*  
and their own proper use and behoof, forever, in fee simple.

Given under my hand and the Great Seal of the said  
state, this *Tenth* day of *November*  
in the year eighteen hundred and *thirteen*, and of  
the Independence of America the third *Eighteenth*.
