and Commander in Chief in and over the said State, and of the Militia thereof.

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, G R E E T I N G:

K NOW YE, That, in Pursuance of the Act for opening the LAND-OFFICE, & by Virtue of the Powers in me vested, I HAVE, given and granted, and, by these Presents, in my Name and Behalf of the said State, DO give and grant unto *Leonard Jasper his* Heirs and Assigns for ever, ALL that Tract or Parcel of Land,

containing two hundred Acres, situate, lying, and being in the County of *Glynn* in the said State, and butting and bounding *On all Sides*

by Vacant Land

SIGNED by his Excellency the GOVERNOR, i.e.

Day of January 1790

having such Shape, Form, and Marks, as appear by a Plat of the same hereunto annexed; together with all and singular the Rights, Members, and Appurtenances thereof, whatsoever, to the full Tract or Parcel of Land belonging, or in any wise appertaining; and also all the Estate, Right, Title, Interest, Claim and Demand of the State aforesaid, of, in, to, or out of, the same; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said Tract or Parcel of Land, and all and singular the Premises aforesaid, with heir and every of their Rights, Members, and Appurtenances, unto the said *Leonard Jasper his* Heirs and Assigns, to his and their own proper Use and Benefit forever, in Fee simple.

GIVEN under my Hand and the Great Seal of the said State, the *Seventeenth*
Day of *December* in the Year of our LORD One Thousand Seven Hundred and
Ninety *Eight*, and in the Month of *Second* New American Independence.
