All that tract of Land, originally granted to Sir Patrick
 Henslow in six tracts adjoining each other, but now
 constituting one tract situated on a branch of
 Green Bank, in the County of Glynn and State of
 Georgia bounded on the North by lands now
 owned by Dr. Wilkinson, formerly known as Stockton
 place, East & South by lands of the Estate of
 Dr. De Larche, and West by lands of Alexander
 McDonald said to contain as originally granted
 Sixteen hundred and fifty Acres, but according
 to a survey of John Mc Tinson surveyor in
 the year Eighteen hundred and three, containing
 Two thousand two hundred and thirty two Acres
 more or less - Together with all and singular
 the houses, out houses, edifices, buildings, heredit-
 -aments rights, minerals and appurtenances to said
tract of land, belonging to or in any wise appertaining
