Bethel be sold by the said Executor or the survivors of them at a
public or private sale and for cash or on credit as to them or

Fifth. We further find that the said Executor or the survivors of them do report their oaths acting and doings in the premises to the Ordinary of Glynn County

Sixth. We further find that the cost and expenses of this proceeding including a reasonable fee to the Complainant's Solicitor be paid by said Executor out of the funds of said Estate in their hands to be administered

Seventh. We further find that the Cost and Expenses of this proceedings and also the fee of John M. Guesard Esq one of the Complainant's Solicitors amounting to the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars be paid by the said Executor out of the funds of said Estate in their hands to be administered
