Comments on Calendar for 1945-46:

Summer Quarter 1945: We begin one day earlier than the calendar provides, and end two days earlier. (We use only one day for second-term registration.) As the summer calendar is already published in our catalogue, we feel that it is not advisable to change.
Fall Quarter 1945: Calendar provides three days for registration -- September 20-21-22. We would have to begin on Tuesday, september 18, to allow time needed for freshman week, aukdveould have upper-class registration on September 2l-22.

The calendar carries the notation in regard to the fall quarter: "52 or 53 school days in 5 -hour course with 3 holidays(Thanksgiving week-end)." Following this calendar, we find that 5 -hour courses meeting Monday through Friday, would meet 58 days, with 2 school days for Thanksgiving.
Winter and Spring Quarters: Calendar carries the notation, "51 school days with one Saturday off." We count 52. Evidently the calendar provides for the stagger system.

Recommended changes for Spring and Summer Quarters: Fegistration for Spring Quarter March 25, classes begin 26 (one day earlyd. Classes end Wednesday, June 5 (one day early). Exams June 6-7-8. (begin one day early; we use only 3 days for exams.) Sunday, June 9, or Monday, June 10. Registration for Summer Quarter, Tuesday, June 11. Then, by making adjustments as to first-term exams, second-term registration day, etc., we can end the summer quarter on August 23 instead of on August 28.

## Comments on Calendar for 2945-46:

Summer Quarter 1945: We begin one day earlier than the calendar provides, and end two days earlier. (We use only one day for second-term registration.) As the summer calendar is already published in our catalogue, we feel that it is not advisable to change.

Fall Quarter 1945: Calendar provides three days for registration -- September 20-21-22. We would have to begin on Tuesday, September 18 , to allow time needed for freshman week. We could have upper-class registration on September 21-22.

The calendar carries the notation in regard to the fall quarter: "52 or 53 school days: in 5 -hours course with 3 holideys(Thanksgiving weekend)." Following this calendar, we find that 5 -hour courses meeting Monday through Friday, would meet 58 days, with 2 school days for Thanksgiving.

Winter and Spring quarters: Calendar carries the notation, "51 school days with one Saturday off" We count 52. Evidently the calendar provides for the stagger system.

Recommended changes for Spring and Summer Quarters: Registration for Spring Quarter March 25, classes begin 26 (one day early. Classes end Wednesday, June 5 (one day early). Exams June 6-7-8. (begin one day early; we use only 3 days for exams.) Graduation Sunday, June 9, or Monday, June 10. Registration for Summer Quarter, Tuesday, June 11. Then, by making adjustments as to first-term exams, second-term registration day, etc.e we can end the summer quarter on August 23 instead of on August 28.
