Bethel Church is the hive of the Busy Bees. The Lord has extracted the stingers so you can get your portion of the Heavenly Honey without getting stung.

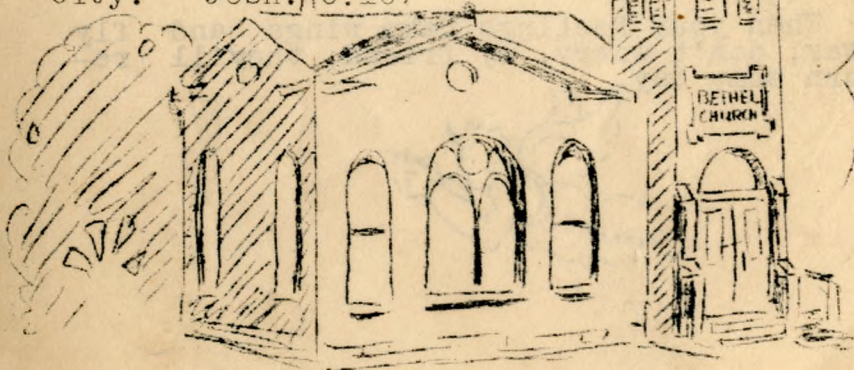
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During the month of Sept. fourteen new members were received into our fellowship.

When your feelings take wings and fly away, don't worry, my friend, they'll return some day.



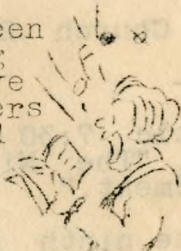


The new chorus for Sunday night:
