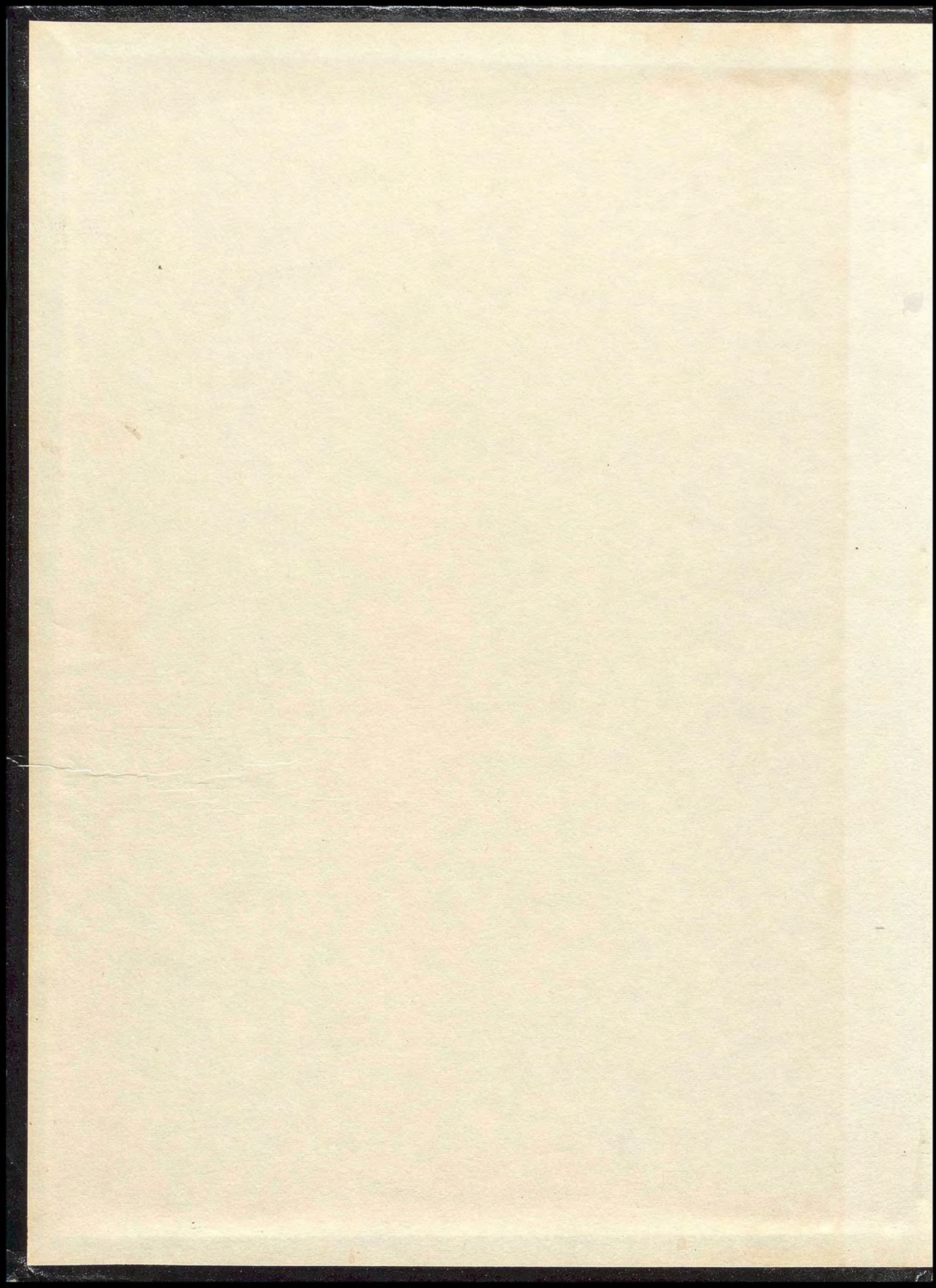

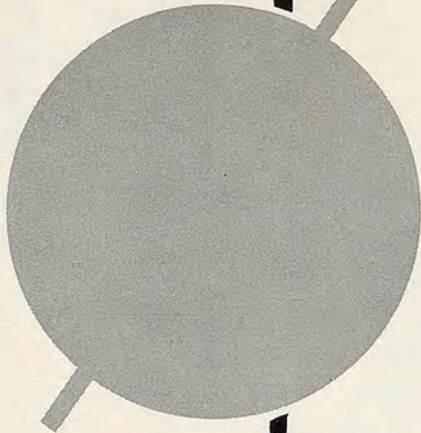
DEDICATED TO DR. L. W. WILLIAMS,
