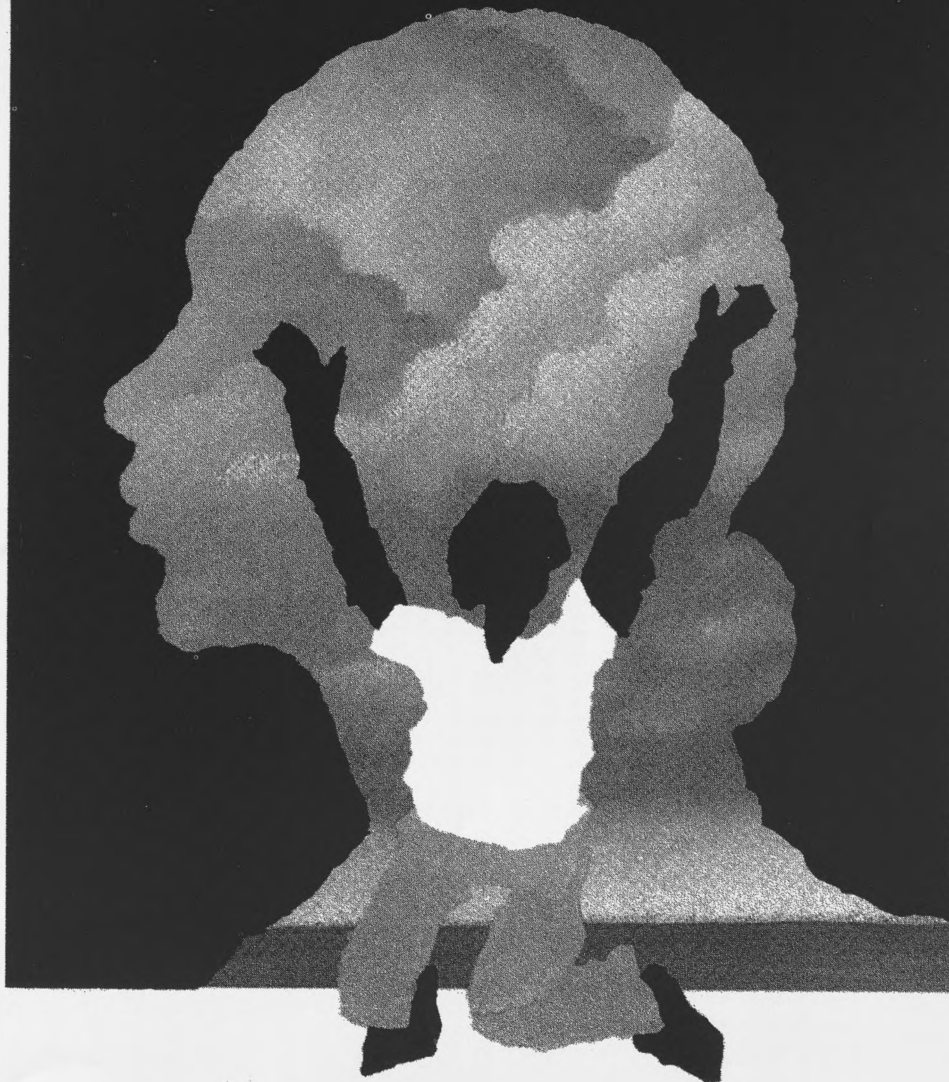

SYNOPSIS

"PORGY AND BESS" is based on the DuBose Heyward novel set in Charleston's famed Catfish Row. It tells the story of a cripple, Porgy who witnesses a murder during a dice game. Porgy later gives shelter to the murderer's woman, the beautiful, haunted Bess. The Catfish Row community is opposed to the union, but Porgy and Bess make each other happy, and their happiness only increases when they have a child orphaned by a hurricane. Their happiness is brief, however, for the murderer, Crown, returns for Bess, and Porgy, defending his family, kills him. The police detain him for questioning but never dream that a cripple could be the killer, so Porgy returns triumphantly to the Row. The triumph turns to tragedy, however, when he learns that, while he was away, Sportin' Life, the dope pusher, seduced Bess with "happy dust" and took her away to New York City to resume, it is implied, her career as a prostitute.

"PORGY AND BESS" is recognized as an American masterpiece, a story that entwines pride, prejudice, pathos and passion through a jazz and blues influenced score. Originally billed as a "Folk Opera," "PORGY AND BESS" introduced classic Gershwin songs like "Summertime", "I Got Plenty O' Nuttin'" and "It Ain't Necessarily So", as well as magnificent and enthralling choruses that stunned music and drama critics alike at its premiere in 1935.

THE GULLAH LANGUAGE

The language of "PORGY and BESS", the Gullah language, is a Creole blend of English and African languages. It was born on Africa's slave coast and developed in the slave communities of the coastal south: South Carolina and Georgia. The Gullah people live in small farming and fishing communities along the Atlantic coastal plain and on the chain of Sea Islands, which run parallel to the coast. Because of their geographical isolation and strong community life, the Gullah have been able to preserve their African cultural heritage through their language, music, arts, their skills and their foods.

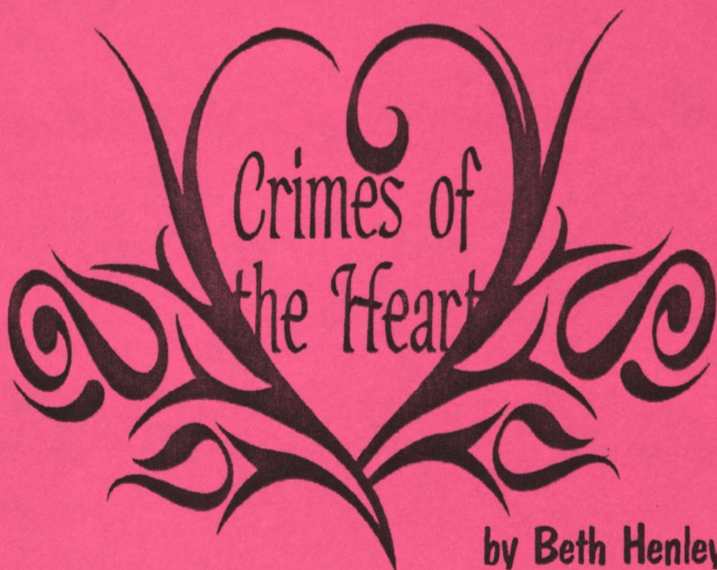

ACTORS' BIOGRAPHIES

DICK VAN PATTEN Few actors have had as versatile and rich a background as Dick Van Patten. With a remarkable career which includes more than 600 radio shows, 27 Broadway plays, 24 feature films and 7 television series, he is still perhaps best known for his popular starring role as Tom Bradford in the long-running hit series, *EIGHT IS ENOUGH*. In recent years, audience interest prompted him to reprise that role in the top-rated television specials, *EIGHT IS ENOUGH: A FAMILY REUNION* and *AN EIGHT IS ENOUGH WEDDING*, both on NBC.

A one time child actor billed as Dickie Van Patten, he appeared in a continuous stream of Broadway shows starting at the age of seven. They included three Pulitzer Prize winners, *ON BORROWED TIME*, *THE SKIN OF OUR TEETH* (starring Taullah Bankhead and Frederick March), and he played Ensign Pulver opposite Henry Fonda's *MISTER ROBERTS*.

In 1949, at the beginning of television, Van Patten made his transition from stage to television in the award-winning *I REMEMBER MAMA* series, portraying Peggy Wood's son Nels, for eight years. Since then, he has made numerous guest starring appearances on almost every major television series, and has starred in such series as *THE PARTNERS*, *ARNIE*, *THE DICK VAN DYKE SHOW* and *WHEN THINGS WERE ROTTEN*.

He has appeared in over 20 feature films, including Mel Brooks' *HIGH ANXIETY*, *SPACEBALLS*, and *ROBIN HOOD MEN IN TIGHTS* as well as having starred in seven movies for Walt Disney in just over three years.

Mr. Van Patten has also been honored with his own star on the Hollywood Walk of Fame.

FRANK GORSHIN was born in Pittsburgh, PA. He was an impressionist who performed at night clubs whenever he got the chance. When Frank Gorshin does one of his impressions, he inhabits a celebrity's personality with an intensity that can be downright scary. His Kirk Douglas impression remains his most amazing.

One of Gorshin's greatest achievements was his portrayal of The Riddler on the *BATMAN* TV show. While other stars played Batman villains for cheap laughs, Gorshin approached his part with a disturbing ferocity. Combining the clenched-jawed passion of Kirk Douglas in *Lust for Life* with the howling homicidal insanity of James Cagney in *WHITE HEAT*, Gorshin's Riddler was the only Batman villain who seemed dangerously unbalanced enough to have a real chance of offing those two caped do-gooders.

Some of the other television shows he's appeared in are *STAR TREK* (as Commissioner Bele in the classic *LET THAT BE YOUR LAST BATTLEFIELD*), *BUCK ROGERS IN THE 25TH CENTURY*, *THE UNTOUCHABLES*, *THE MUNSTERS*, and more recently he starred as Dr. Fletcher in the movie *THE TWELVE MONKEYS*. He also recently voiced Foghorn Leghorn and Yosemite Sam. His other TV guest appearances include such shows as *LOIS AND CLARK: THE NEW ADVENTURES OF SUPERMAN*, *ARE YOU AFRAID OF THE DARK?*, *MURDER, SHE WROTE*, *MONSTERS*, *THE FALL GUY*, *WONDER WOMAN*, *CHARLIE'S ANGELS*, *S.W.A.T.*, *HAWAII FIVE - O*, *NAKED CITY*, and *THE REN AND STIMPY SHOW* voicing the Reverend Jack Cheese in the episode "Jack Cheese".

Mr. Gorshin has recently portrayed the late George Burns in a new one man play entitled *SAY GOODNIGHT, GRACIE*, and continues his comedy career appearing regularly in Las Vegas and Atlantic City.

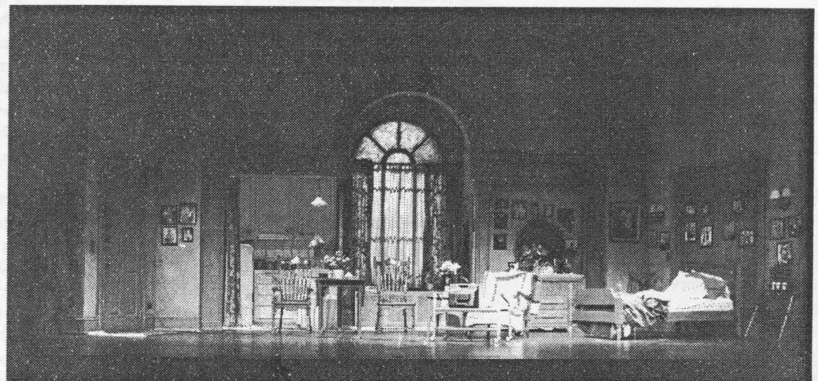

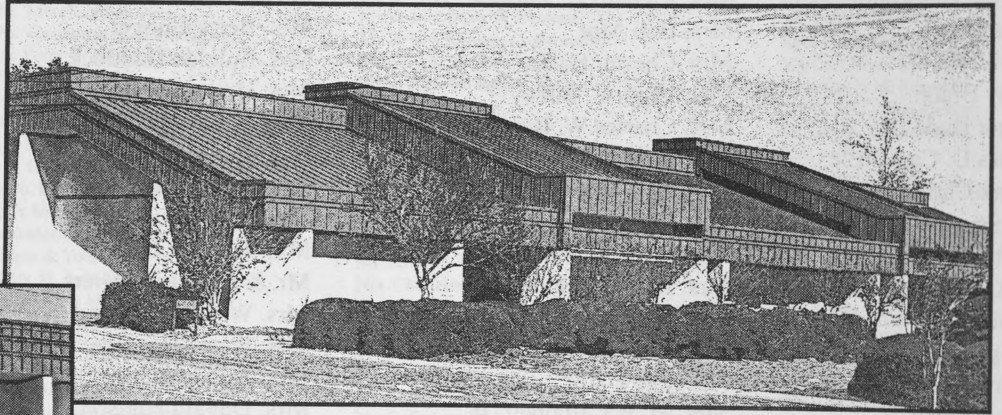
