- * **1992 Arts Aloff** - Festival of Artistic Activities hosted by S.A.L. Over 20 award-winning regional artists participated in this event.
- * **August 1992** - Lowndes / Valdosta Arts Commission "Best of the Best" Art Show viewed by over 1,000 people.
- * **Featured Artists Program** - Different members works displayed each month at First State Bank, Lake Park Library and The Valdosta Daily Times.
- * **The Crescent House** - S.A.L. sponsored and decorated an exhibit in the Ballroom of this century-old house.
