Morven vet returns to Vietnam

■ Farmer trains Vietnamese how to grow tobacco

MORVEN — Stepping off a transport aircraft at Tan Son Nhut, Vietnam, the first sight to meet Andrew Jackson's eyes was the last one he saw upon leaving the country in 1969 — fighter plane revetments, or retaining walls.

The Vietnam veteran remembered them well this month while on a U.S. Department of Agriculture trade mission to Southeast Asia.

"There they were — just like when I left," said Jackson, a 50-year-old Air Force Vietnam veteran. "That hadn't changed at all ... the rest of the country that I saw is very different, but those revetments were still there, like they were waiting around to be used."

Of course, the sandbagged steel shells designed to protect war planes are empty now; gone are the A-37, F-4 and F-100 aircraft and the American GIs that used the shelters.

However, Jackson's visit marks a return of U.S. assistance to the small Southeast Asia nation. Jackson, a supervisor with the USDA, traveled to Vietnam and spent two weeks teaching 68 Asian tobacco businessmen and farmers how to

employees represent a shift in U.S. relations with Vietnam. The past three years have signaled a more open economic association with a former enemy

wrong. But as I look back, I can see it was all about money; about what company was going to get what in South Vietnam," Jackson said. "All that's over

was involved in three decades ago. In 1969, Vietnam was a divided nation. The north was ruled by communists, and the south was run by an American

Jackson never had the opportunity to travel to northern part of the nation until his USDA mission brought him to Hanoi, Vietnam's capital city.

After retirement from Eastman Kodak he returned to Brooks County where he was elected the first black County Commissioner in 1986 and County Chairman. He became the first black Chairman of The Coastal Plain Area, EOA, Inc; first black appointed to the Criminal Justice Coordinating Council by then Governor Sonny Perdue; first black to head up FEMA in Brooks County; the organizer and CEO of South Georgia Foster and Adoptive Parents Association, Inc; the MLK County Committee; on the Board of Health, Board of DFCS and numerous other civic and public committees. He is a licensed Broker and assists many families with estate planning. He was a leading voice in the Quitman 10 + 2 Justice Movement and one of the founders of Calvary Christian Center. As we celebrate Black History month, we take this time to recognize a true, historical black leader; my dad, Mr. James Henry Maxwell. THANK YOU!

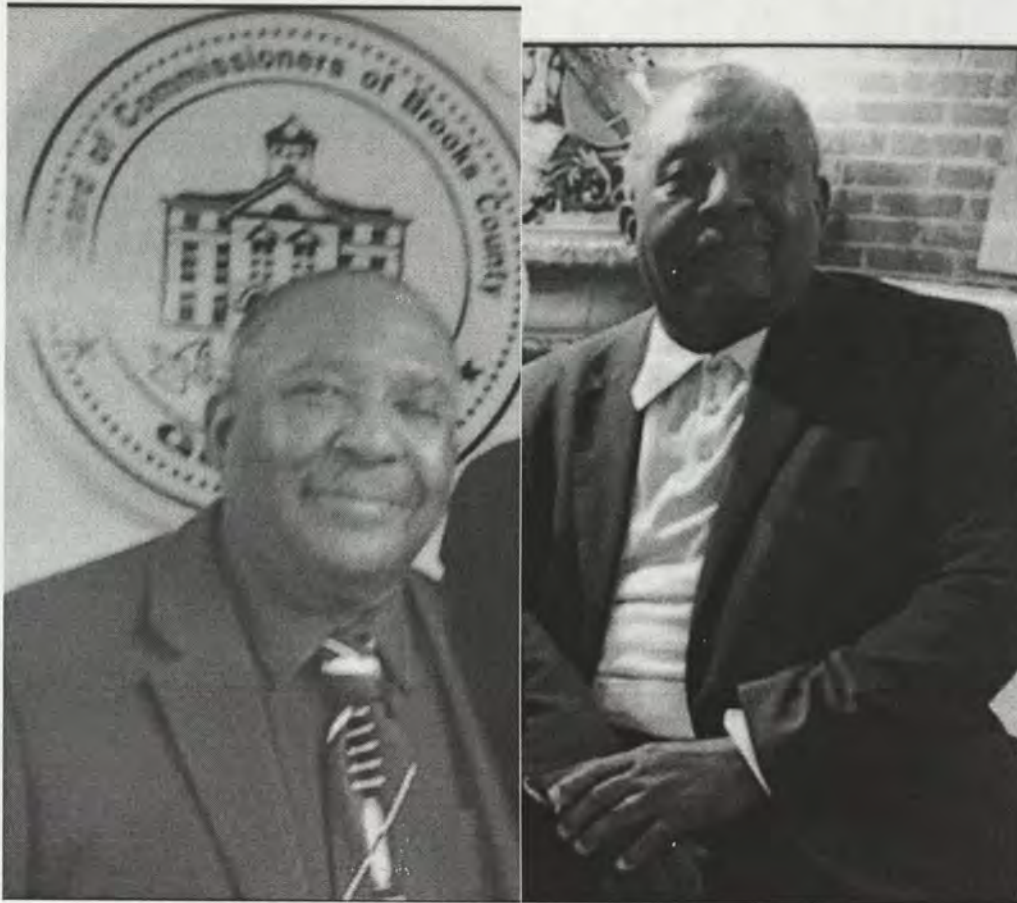

As the Father of 9 children and 23 grandchildren, James Henry Maxwell has worn and continues to wear many hats. Born October 23, 1946 to Thomas Maxwell (1874-1962) and Rosa Brown Maxwell (1903-1983), James is a true Son of Brooks County. This distinguished "Drummer" of the Marching Washington Street High School Wildcats Band graduated in 1966 then moved to Rochester, New York where he met and married the late China (2020) and worked at Eastman Kodak. He was then drafted into the U.S. Army where he served valiantly in the Viet Nam War and became a recipient of a Purple Heart and numerous other certificates of valor. After discharge he returned to Eastman Kodak where he was a Lab Technician and Supervisor for over 20 years. He graduated from Empire State College with a BS in Business. After retirement from Eastman Kodak, he returned to Brooks County where he was elected the first black County Commissioner in 1993. He is the Head Elder at Calvary Christian Center of South Georgia and recently served as the Chair of the Brooks County Commissioners and now serves as the Vice Chair. James is also actively involved with several other organizations in the community. He has previously served as Chairman of the FEMA Board and is currently a member of the Board of Health, Board of Coastal Plains Area EOA, Inc., President and Founder of South Georgia Foster & Adoptive Parents Association, Inc., organizing partner of the MLK County Committee, Board of DFCS, the Brooks County NAACP and numerous other civic and public committees. He is also the current Chair of the Brooks County Democratic Committee. James was the first black Chairman of the Coastal Plain Area EOA, Inc and the first black appointed to the Criminal Justice Coordinating Council

Bradford William and Laura Spencer's Family

1833 to Present

Our Family History

Bradford Spencer was born in Screven County, Georgia around 1833-1835. Born into slavery, he was the son of William George Wiley Lane and a black slave, Precilla (Cilla) Spencer. Later, Priscilla married Joseph Neloms. Bradford had several half brothers and sisters whose last name was Neloms.

His paternal (Caucasian) lineage: Bradford is the great-great grandson of James Lane and Sarah Arnold; the great-grandson of Etheldred Lane, a veteran of the Revolutionary War; the grandson of Wiley Lane and Sarah Spence, and of course, the son of William and Cilla. Sarah Spence was the daughter of Insel Spence, whose plantation it is believed to be where Bradford was born. Insel Spence was born in 1750 in Dobbs County, North Carolina and died in 1833 in Georgia. Insel Spence had vast holdings in many counties in the state of Georgia. Insel had a checkered and criminal past that included robberies, breaking and entering, and soliciting to have his young wife murdered for which he served jail time. He also was sued in civil court by William G. Lane when he was 18 years old in order to regain his inheritance that Insel was accused of stealing. Insel stated he would flee to the territory of Florida before he would give his orphaned grandson anything! William George Wiley Lane was named administrator of his grandfather's estate and was the overseer of his plantation when Brad was born.

His maternal (African) lineage: It is theorized that Bradford's mother, Precilla was purchased from one of the Spencer plantations in the Screven/Effingham counties, thus the reason for our last name. It must be noted that no Spencer Plantations were in Lowndes or Brooks counties. In the mid 1830s

The deed also shows a woman aged 45 with the name of Mahala and a brother by the name of Mack. It has been documented that Laura had a half brother by the name of Mack Lane by several relatives.

It has been said that Brad was initially given a wife while in bondage but there were no children from this arrangement. After the Emancipation, Brad married Laura, the woman of his choice. This marriage occurred about 1866-67, and they had their first child, James (JT) in July of 1868. they subsequently had 13 more children: Otto (OB), June 1870; Barger (BJ), February 1872; Alberta, January 1872; Mahalia, 1876; Ernest, 1879; Austin, December 12, 1883; Corene, April 1885; Mamie, January 1886; Madelyn (aka Mattie), December 1887; Shellie, November 1889; Connie, January 1891; Leroy, March 8, 1897 and Lula who died in infancy.

Brad and Laura were successful farmers acquiring approximately 400 acres of land, purchasing the old H.D. Mashburne place in 1882. They also owned land in the town of Quitman. They were both original member of Macedonia Baptist Church where they were outstanding member in the church and community. They worked tirelessly to instill the work ethic in their children and the importance of an education as well.

Brad and Laura were married for approximately 30 years before Laura was called home in 1897. Brad followed her in death a year and a half later. From these two there are hundreds of descendants living today. They both left a legacy that endures today as we feel it is our duty as their descendants to honor their lives and the contributions they made to the uplifting of the African American. Whatever your walk in life we are to rejoice and be exceedingly glad that they lived and loved so many years ago.

Updated Bio of the Honorable Brad & Laura Spencer

At this point in our ongoing attempts to create a more comprehensive biography of our forebears the following new information has been unearthed by Janet Elder. Please be mindful that this has not been corroborated as of yet; however, it is highly likely that the following is accurate. You be the judge.

*Bradford Spencer was most likely born in Screven County @1833-1835 not in Brooks County as originally thought to William G. Lane and an enslaved woman by the name of (Pris) Cilla Spencer who later married Joseph Neloms. Brad had several half brothers and sisters whose last name was Neloms.

Janet has also uncovered several plantation owners in Screven/Effingham counties with the last name of Spencer and it's theorized that Cilla was purchased from one of them thus the reason for our last name. It should be noted that there were no Spencer Plantations in Lowndes or Brooks Counties and her reasoning make sense.


+Laura was born @1850 and was purchased from the estate of the late Colonel Blalock of Madison County, Florida in 1858 by William G. Lane. The deed states that Laura was "light color" and 8 years old. The deed also shows a woman aged 45 with the name of Mahala and a brother by the name of Mack. It has been documented that Laura had a half-brother by the name of Mack Lane by several relatives who were alive when I started my research. So it's safe to say that this is our Laura as it puts her on the same plantation as Brad.

I will not reiterate their biographies in great detail here but refer all first time attendees to visit our Facebook page: Spencer Family Society (Quitman, GA) to read more about our common ancestor and to peruse all documents that are on that site.

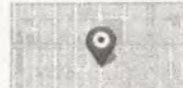

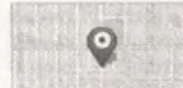
