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
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Krampus Parade 2021

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

I lost all connection to myself and pretty much everyone around me. I was angry. I blacked out. Going into high school, I started drinking. It helped to numb me. I pretty much became "the party girl" and maintained that status for years. Those years were... let's just say, not easy.

I don't want to say that they were all bad because the truth is, they weren't. I laughed just as much as I cried. Deities of Yule

Yule is celebrated on December 21. It is one of the eight Sabbats celebrated by Pagans (Wiccans, Druids, Heathens, Witches, Magicians, Kemetics, etc.) on the Wheel of the Year. On that day (or close to it), an amazing thing happens in the sky. The earth's axis tilts away from the sun in the Northern Hemisphere, and the sun reaches its greatest distance from the equatorial plane. It is the longest night of the year and is a celebration of the return of the light as the nights become shorter and the days become longer. Many cultures have winter festivals that are in fact celebrations of light. In addition to Christmas, there's Hanukkah with its brightly lit menorahs, Kwanzaa candles, and any number of other holidays. As a festival of the Sun, the most important part of any Yule celebration is light: candles, bonfires, and more. Celebrate the sun's return by preparing all kinds of winter foods; cornbread, a pot of buttered rum, plum pudding, cranberry dressing, game stew,

St. Nicholas is commonly linked to Odin, the ruler of Asgard, one of the major gods in Germanic mythology who was depicted as a whitebearded man with magical powers. However, Odin's ties to Santa Claus may be more pronounced. The winter solstice, also known as Yule, was a time when Odin led a hunting party, known as the Wild Hunt, in the sky with an eight-legged horse named Sleipnir. The 13th century Poetic Edda said the mythical

horse could leap great distances - a trait reindeer possess. Children would leave their boots by the chimney, filled with carrots and hay to feed Sleipnir. Legend has it that whenever Odin flew by, he would leave gifts by their boots. Frau Holda is the Germanic goddess of winter. In German folk legends, she is depicted as a beautiful blonde who is the protector of children's souls. Like Odin, she would fly through the night and give gifts to children. In some depictions, Holda is dressed in red and uses chimneys to deliver gifts. Some Germanic traditions involve leaving food and milk for Holda Dec. 24, known as Mother Night.

Setting up a Yule Altar

Winter is here, and even if the snow hasn't fallen yet, there's a definite chill in the air. Use cold colors to decorate your altar, such as blues and silvers and whites. Also find ways to include the reds, whites, and greens of the season. If you're using white on your altar at Yule, consider incorporating it into rituals that focus on purification, or your spiritual development. Since winter solstice is the season of the sun, gold is often associated with solar power and energy. If your tradition honors the return of the sun, hang some gold suns around your house as a tribute. Use a gold candle to represent the sun on your altar.

Cover your altar with a cloth in a cool color, and then add

candles in a variety of different wintry shades. Use candles in similar colors. Add solar symbols to your altar. Gold discs, yellow candles, anything bright and shiny can represent the sun. A large pillar candle, inscribed with solar symbols, can be designated as the sun candle. You can also add evergreen boughs, sprigs of holly, pine cones, a Yule log, and even Santa Claus. Consider antlers or reindeer, along with other symbols of fertility.

Try incorporating sacred plants associated with the winter solstice as well. Evergreen boughs like pines, fir, juniper, and cedar are all part of the evergreen family, and they're typically associated with themes of protection and prosperity, as well as that of a continuation of life and renewal. Hang a sprig of holly in your house to ensure good luck and safety to your family. Wear it as a charm, or make holly water (which you probably read as holy water!) by soaking leaves overnight in spring water under a full

Use birch branches to craft your besom for magical workings and in spells and rituals related to enchantments, renewal, purification, fresh starts, and new beginnings.

Consider some of these items as part of your Sabbat decor:

fruit, nuts, mistletoe, snowflakes,


icicles, a bowl of snow, candy canes, bells, and sun wheels.

- •Incense/Resin (Frankincense, Myrrh, Loban, Cinnamon, cinnamon-orange, Cinnamon-Apple, Cedar, and Clove)
- Charcoals
- •God/Goddess statue
- Offering bowl
- •Lemon Quartz (for abundance, warmth, creativity)
- •Golden Calcite (for super energy)
- Sunstone (for creativity)
- Unakite (for joy in daily life)
- •Ametrine (for optimism)
- •Goldstone (pure sparkling vitality!)
- •Lepidolite (Violet ray burns away greyness)

Hemimorphite (increases energy to complete projects).





Fate Calculation

The Imaginator

At first, there is a whiteness in my head that is similar to the glaring star brightness from a piece of blank paper. I imagine a black pen, whose nib draws a circle that draws itself ouroboros?—with a punctiform in its center, and from that, a single black line that connects the intermediacy to the edge. This line will represent a thing in general, whatever is so appropriate for a thought-manifesting-creature called human, that is connected to the origin of the interior dot of the ouroboros circle to the emanation of its presumed outer edges, and beyond, if possible.

Is that possible? An ouroboros is also a circle; not an infinity figure, but not quite a simple circle either. Such visualizations are reconfiguration of sapience required for higher thought, for abstract thought; this is to come close to the mystery of mysteries, the spiritual experience. The encompassing of fervor and desire that devours certain individuals who realize the realization of existence, and that there is more than what manifests as forms to the eyes, sounds to the ears, words to the mouth.

Another line was drawn in the

time the above paragraph was read - from its center, despite the presence of an observer who kept the image of this circle vaguely in mind. But how? Nobody was looking. Then, another line is connected to the edge—surprise—filling in another absence, but the circle has only begun the fine contours of its shape. So many things are happening, so many things are affiliated through the relation of these shapes' (dot, circle, line) interconnectedness. The circle and its thinly cut lines are exacted by an intangible knife whose qualities lie between phantasmagorical and sublime, two qualities which always envelope the physical world.

We only have to look askance for these interpreted relationships.

Spells—perhaps I could say, intentions?—are crafted with that intangible knife, and the hands that carve each one are equipped with a particular exactitude - though it would also sometimes manifest as a miracle, even if the work is not meticulous! - that is in essence, the destiny of a manifestation. It is an intricate fate calculation. What I mean is, we, the existent, the so-called enactor of all things, think of a

cause to manifest: joy/sorrow; blessings/curses; binaries/ singularities. Then, invisible probabilities are calculated from an abacus. Questions are asked, answers are given. They are all correct, and the fates of each line are dormant, waiting as potentials. It is utterly beautiful. All these answer/ intention hybrids have already happened/is happening/will happen. The slash is the connector between subject and will, object and force. These gorgeous intangibilities began with a thought, a circle, no—a spiral. This shape has evolved into a conflagration of words, the soul of language. Yes, it is true: all these expressions are interconnected.

This is the wonder in a thing, its expressions and connections. Language is a soul that permeates throughout qualia. The connectedness of the encompassing, the splendor and passions of all things, reminds me of Buddhist Enlightenment, DKMU Paradigm Shifting, Thelema's Great Work, and so many other threatening phrases whose authority is elevated with a simple inclusion of a capitalized letter.

All these things are around us, waiting in silence and noise. In

between, each one is seen, heard, intuited. Nouns, adjectives, observations. Who is it that can understand these connections? Everyone can, actually, but it is magicians and witches and poets who will, those who embody the meaning of the thing while eternally reconciling the paradox of the I and the intended manifestation. Does a manifestation need an I to initialize it? Quite often, I am told that the universe will take care of it, and that most, if not all constructs of the I is to be discarded and forgotten so that a sigil's purpose is left to the cosmic, and that the primordial we can begin its unconscious

This is all still underneath the contours of fate calculation, the transformation of potential meaning into meaning made physical. But this is also how unreality transforms into reality, how Meinong's ontology seamlessly weaves itself into our existence/ subsistence/abstinence, and how magic is everywhere, imbued in everything. The circle is already complete—it always has been—and its center is the origin (what/who/ why is it?) from which the black lines that protrude from it begin the intricacy of manifesting. And yet, all this magnificence, all the exactitude of love and care that wielders wield this intangible knife—ritual—with, is still just one line carving another line. All for the sake of expressing reality with desired meanings.

And yet we still wonder if fate exists. &

Cranberry Prosperity Sauce Gabrielle Xanthus

Growing up with a kitchen witch was always such a delight for the holidays! My mother had so many beautiful recipes that were handed down to her by my great grandmother and she used them every year. My absolute favorite was her Cranberry sauce which included spiced apple and orange. Even the smell is enough to brighten your spirits and add a bit of abundance to your home. Recipe 1 bag of cranberries

½ cup of honey

1 green apple

1 orange

1 cup of orange juice

1/2 tbs of cinnamon and clove 1 teaspoon of nutmeg and allspice

Peel and chop the orange and apple into small diced squares. Combine all the ingredients in a medium saucepan. Place the pan on the stove and bring to a boil stirring the ingredients together until fully combined. Then reduce the heat to simmer for 20 minutes. After you will cover the pot and remove it from the heat allowing time for it to cool to room temperature before storing or serving. This sauce will live in the refrigerator for up to 2 weeks or frozen to enjoy all year long.

As you add each ingredient to tne pot, take a moment to hold them in your hands and feel the intention: Apple is for love, orange is for luck, cinnamon is for protection, clove removes negative energy, nutmeg is for health, allspice is for wealth, and honey is the sweetness that binds it altogether. While you are stirring, be sure to chant this blessing into the sauce to imbue it with all those warm holiday vibes. Once is enough but if you feel the urge to repeat it, then trust that intuition and say it as many times as you feel it needs.

"With this apple so bright I

give my love. With this orange so ripe I bring prosperity. Cinnamon, clove and spice are my blessing of health, wealth and wholeness to all those who share in this."

When you are spicing your sauce, just remember to trust your intuition. Some spices may be stronger than others based on where they come from. Be sure to use your nose and follow your heart to get the balance just right.

Psychic Protection for the Holiday Season

It's the holiday season and time to visit friends and family, or maybe this year they may be coming to stay with you. This is also the season of higher exposure to psychic contamination, when you come under oppression from the telepathic or empathic influence of those close relationships. All humans are intuitive, and have energy bodies that interact with everything around them, including you. This can lead to feeling not-yourself as you are overwhelmed by other people's energy, or having your own energy stimulated negatively. This can potentially leave you feeling off for months after the holidays or even feeling steadily worse year after year. It doesn't have to be that way. You can take back responsibility for your own energy body and life experience!

We may be feeling reluctant about the festivities ahead, even as we may be glad to see our loved ones, because of how we have felt in the past during holidays. In years past, you may have already experienced many of the symptoms of psychic contamination from your close relations. How can we protect ourselves this season, and going forward? These are some methods you can utilize:

Assume good intentions and good things. People subconsciously respond to what we are thinking and feeling. And when we expect hostility, we can even plant those feelings into them when otherwise they might have acted differently. The default is we are all influencing each other all the time. Try putting yourself in a benevolent place first, as it will deflect ill will being directed at you and not add negativity to others.

Energy shielding. There are many ways to do this, and the one that will work best for you will depend a little on your own experimentation.
Essentially, you will want to imagine or sense yourself inside of a sphere, made of any material/energy/barrier that you fully feel will be protective and that for you defines where you end and everyone else begins.

My preferred method was taught to me by my teacher and she referred to it as the Rose-Cross Shield¹. You begin by standing, then using your dominant hand you draw a golden (imagine this, or simply intend it) equal armed cross in the air in front of you. Then pointing at the center of the cross, see a white rose bud open and bloom. As it blooms, you draw a spiral outwards and clockwise from the center of the cross out to the ends of the cross-arms. Then in a line move your arm across to point to your right, and repeat drawing the symbol. You will repeat drawing the rose cross behind you and to the left of you. Then move your arm to connect the crosses in a circle, joined by golden rose briars. With your hand pointing in front of you again, swing your hand down to draw the symbol below you, then move your hand backwards in an arc until you are pointing above you, and draw the rose cross above you. Move your arm to connect the crosses above, in front, below, and behind you in a vertical circle. End with your hand pointing to the ground so that you can move it out to your side, and connect the crosses to your right, below you, to your left, and above you. You will end with three gold rings connecting the crosses. You can additionally intend or visualize that the spaces between the rings are

filled with more golden briar, or with golden light. This shield has served me well over the years. You'll need to cast it at least once a day, and you can reinforce it if you feel the need to throughout the day.

Fully being in your own space. Either imagine seeing a ball, or imagine feeling a ball/pulse of energy in the center of your body. This is your essence and soul. See or feel that ball expand outwards, so you are encasing yourself in energy that is just yours. As that energy pushes outwards, it pushes out and away energy that is not yours. Continue until the sphere extends a few feet away from your body in all directions. Tell yourself that in your sphere is only your energy, and that outside your sphere is everyone and everything else. Repeat that to yourself a few times while feeling that separation between you and the environment. You can do this whenever you are feeling suffocated or intruded upon, as a way to reassert your boundaries and autonomy.

Once you have left an event or gone home from visiting, it will be helpful to take the next week to thoroughly clear your energy. Some tips for detoxing afterwards:

Detaching through mindfulness. Pay attention to each of your senses one at a time. Breathe. Have your attention right where you are now. Breathe. Tell yourself that you let go of anything that is not yours. You release every moment before now.

Cleansing. I suggest using multiple methods, to be sure you have removed anything that isn't serving you. Some methods include:

- •grounding your energy into the earth - which to do, you need to just imagine feeling the energy move down out of your body and aura and down deep into the ground
- •standing in sunlight and asking it to purify you
- •asking the wind to blow through your aura, clearing everything away
- •salt (which is purifying) baths
- •fumigating your aura with incenses, plants, or resins like nag champa, frankincense, or rosemary
- •using crystals to clear away your energy like black kyanite and selenite by using a sweeping motion across yourself
- •putting energy into herbal teas with plants that have purifying properties such as: basil, cinnamon, rosemary, and lemon (not all together of course, that would taste strange!).

Regain your own sense of balance by engaging in activities that re-connect you with your sense of self and your daily rhythms. What those activities are can include anything that connects you to your peace.

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"What's your sign?"

Possibly the most infamous pick up line ever. For over a millennia, humans have used Astrology to predict events. And most recently, Astrology has been used as a tool for interpreting one's own patterns of thinking and being in order to spark personal empowerment and expansion. It is so popular that almost anyone in the Western world can flip to the horoscopes section of their local newspaper or find them within the pages of their favorite magazine. But what is your sign? Why are people always asking us?

What is Astrology?

Astrology is a form of divination and/or system of thought that uses the Earth's position as relative to the Sun and planetary bodies to interpret the energy of our reality. There are 3 main pieces to understanding Astrology:

- The Planets which rule over particular aspects of our reality and How the process of fulfilling that motivation.
- 2. The Signs of the Zodiac determine how the motivations of planetary influence manifest themselves as a blend of unique characteristics and behavioral tendencies.
- 3. The Houses which determine what areas of our lives in which these motivations will manifest. Today, we will be exploring the signs of the Zodiac.

What is the Zodiac?

Again, astrology is calculated based upon the Earth's position as relative to the Sun and other planetary bodies. From there, the cosmos is also divided into twelve sections. Each section is named after a constellation that falls within its realm and these sections are known as the Zodiac. As we travel around the Sun - though,



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we on Earth, are the ones in motion - from our position on Earth it gives the illusion that the Sun is "moving" through each of the twelve signs in one calendar year. In addition, the planets then move through the signs as they make their own way around the Sun.

Our own signs are determined by our personal star charts, a record of the positions of the luminary bodies (Sun and Moon) as well as the planets at the times of our births. When someone refers to their sign, this is in reference to the sign the Sun falls under, as it is often the most dominant sign in one's chart. Each Zodiac sign has its own unique blend of characteristics that can help us explore our own patterns of thinking, being and help understand ourselves on a deeper level so we may grow. To better understand our signs, we must understand that each of the signs are each a blend of their ruling planetary influence, their element and their modality.

Elements


The signs of the Zodiac

Yuletide Peppermint Cheer Heidi Jensen

As the weather gets colder and colder, the season of Yule swiftly approaches. Although Yule is a time for joy and cheer, often it also comes with depression, and cold. A time when bugs and rodents turn inward looking for warmth. Peppermint oil is great at curing all of these ailments. The genus name for peppermint is Mentha and it comes from the Greek word Minthe. Minthe was a nymph in Greek mythology who was beloved by Hades. She was transformed into the mint plant by his jealous wife Persephone. She would then step on Minthe with all her might time and time again,

with each step she released the plant's sweet aroma.

While many of us rather enjoy the smell of Peppermint, this aroma is unpleasant to many insects and rodents. In order to help with the control of these, mix 2-3 drops of the oil per cup of water. Add the mixture to a spray bottle and mist all doorways, windows, and along the borders of rooms and the outer perimeter of the house, garden, or any other location where they may wander. This should be done at every two weeks. This same mixture is also said to help keep negativity away and aids in protecting the home.




Since the earliest of time,

being used in Greek and Roman feasts. They used it in wreaths, table decorations and, best of all, mixed into wine and sauces as a flavouring agent. There are also mentions, as early as the 13th century, in Icelandic Pharmacopoeias and was cultivated by Egyptians. In Scotland, it was a medieval flavouring in whiskey. As you can gather, it has been used as a digestive and herbal aid for many centuries and in many regions of the world.

Many still use Peppermint oil today. Ingesting peppermint can help to relieve the symptoms of various cold and flu viruses. A classic cold remedy, that will also unblock the sinuses, is: two drops of food-grade Peppermint essential oil, two drops of foodgrade Eucalyptus essential oil and two tablespoons of lemon juice in a cup of hot water. First, inhale the mixture and then drink it while it remains warm. Adding honey to the mixture will soothe a sore throat. Peppermint applied at the wrist has been used to ensure that you will not become ill. You can also make an ointment that can be used on the chest and under the nose to aid with congestion. You will need: 1/2 oz. Eucalyptus Oil, 1/2 oz. Rosemary Oil, 1/2 oz. Peppermint Oil, 2 oz Hard Paraffin Wax, and 2 oz Soft Paraffin Wax. Melt these

ingredients together and stir as it cools down. You'll want to make certain you mix the mixture well. Then, store it in an airtight container with a label and away from heat. This can be applied several times a day, as needed.

Unfortunately, colds, the flu and other such viruses are not the only ailments that plague us during winter. The colder months also tend to bring on more depressive states of mind. We may find ourselves restless and/or bogged down with worry and fear. To aid with headaches, as a result of such worry, rub Peppermint oil on your temples, back of the neck, and on the pressure points next to and behind your ears. Spray your pillow, or place a satchel with Unakite and a few drops of Peppermint under your pillow, to encourage sleep and peaceful dreams. This will allow the heart to open to joy and also access the vibrational healing properties of both the Peppermint oil and Unakite.

Many times they may induce prophetic dreams of the future or help work through shadow work from the past and present. Journal what takes place, even the small details - everything that sticks out.

You can also use Peppermint oil in spells to create positive changes in your life. For example, this spell uses candles, anointed with peppermint essential oil, to help lift your spirits when you need inspiration. Set your altar/space up with an Unakite stone, a white candle, an indigo candle and a mixing jar with lid. Mix three drops of Peppermint oil with 2 teaspoons of carrier oil, such as almond, into the jar. Light the white candle and focus on your intention. Hold the mixture in your hands and focus that intention and energy into the oil. Once you feel it is well charged, take the indigo candle and inscribe it with something meaningful to you - a sigil, a phrase, or even the word joy.

Anoint that candle with your mixture, return it to it's holder and light it. Chant the following:

Oh Powers that be,

Please send inspiration down to me.

Fill my mind with energy to cheer

And remove all traces of fear.

Let it be and.

Blessed Be.

As the candle melts, feel all your worry and stress melt away. Let go of all that negative energy. Let joy, light, and cheerfulness feel your heart and soul!



What do the Gods get out of Their Relationships with Us?

What do the Gods get out on Their Relationships with us?

On September 21, 2011, Ravenari posted this question on the Pagan Veil, a now extinct chat room:

"If you are one of the many (or few) who sees Gods as individual entities that exist with or without our help (and not as individual greater parts of a whole); what do you think They get out of helping you? Why does a God connect to, or even 'own' someone in an intensive relationship? And how could what we as humans offer ever really be hugely significant to Them? Or is it that we bother to make the offerings at all? What do you think the Gods get out of your relationship with Them?"

Squirrelly Productions in Spokane decided to present this topic for discussion at one of their coffees. The answers were interesting and varied.

The resident cynic, of course, blurted out, "Entertainment!" Several nearly spewed their drinks, which of course, only gave credence to his statement. After all, how many of us have not, at one time or another, felt that a Deity had a good laugh at our expense?

Then the discussion became more serious, though it was hard to stay focused on the original question without addressing what a Deity really is. Everyone seems to have their own ideas, even when it comes down to individual Deities. My concept of the Morrigan - and how She appears to me, for example - is very different from how some

others perceive Her as the wise Crone.

A number of people on a variety of paths (Hellenic, Wicca, Asatru) perceive a parent-child relationship, with humans in the role of children of course. In this sense, the Gods are there to teach and help us grow for future lives. One Hellenistic follower told a story of how Hera taught her a lesson on vanity by requiring her to cut her hair; while others cited an ancestral connection with their Deity. While a Deity may or may not be helping us toward a higher level of spirituality, this line of discussion begged the question of why. What does the Deity get out of helping us in this manner? The best response was an analogy to parents getting pride out of watching their children grow, and the reward of teaching them. This ascribes a nurturance role to the Deities that really doesn't fit all of Them. Aries or Loki as nurturing Gods is a somewhat difficult concept, at least for

The participants who saw their Deity in this manner were all mothers, with strong nurturing motivations themselves. That raises the question of whether we perceive a Deity in terms of Jungian archetypal images. As such, They exist as we perceive Them, and like certain quantum mechanical phenomena, perhaps a Deity does not exist without us to believe in and perceive. In this manner of thinking, what a Deity gets from Their relationship with us, is everything: Their very

Another participant saw their Deity as a personification of

energy and that the exchange of energy between mortals and a Deity is what the Gods get out of the relationship. As mortals, we do not work directly with a Deity, but rather with energy. A Deity gets more energy from worshipers than what it would without worshippers and can, therefore, channel more energy as they see fit. One would think, however, that the further a Being moves from having a material form, the more energy it must have (matter being converted to energy according to Einstein's equations). Why would a Being of such immense energy need our paltry human contribution?

One person in the group brought up the idea that we cannot know the motivations of Deities. Another countered with the idea that we can look at Their lore to understand Their motivations. Undoubtedly, the further removed a Being is from our Earthly level, the more powerful Their energy level. Undeniably, there are Beings of awesome power and unfamiliar energies so far removed from the human experience that They become unknowable and unfathomable to our limited senses and psychic abilities. But are these the Deities we relate to in our craft?

All these arguments imply that the Gods, at least the ones we can relate to, have motivations. This makes the Deities much like us. Some want power; some want a nurturing relationship; some recognition. Most have Their own agenda that They are trying to achieve. Each Deity has a set of motivations unique to that Deity. This makes Them

psychologically just like humans; just like many of the other spiritual beings with which we share this and other planes of existence.

Plants will grow in the garden without our help; but, not the plants we want. Some aspects of a Deity are creating and growing the garden as They want it to grow. They have an agenda for us, and it is unlikely that Their various agendas are perfectly aligned. Some of Their agendas may actually conflict, such as in the myth of Prometheus versus Zeus.

Perhaps Poppy Palin said it best in Craft of the Wild Witch. When we take on a patron Goddess or God, we make a promise. We do not promise to worship necessarily; but we do promise, as fellow sentient beings, that:

"we will express Their will, Their way and Their wisdom to the world. We are incarnate and They are not. We can make manifest change while They are not able to express Themselves in a way considered substantial. We have the means of making a difference while on Earth while They may be given little credence in the modern frame of reference. Yet for all the disregard They are accustomed to experiencing in human realms, They have that which is most valuable to us: greater access to truths, to that which is hidden to our mortal eyes at present."

They are our link to that which is beyond human perception. We are Their link to this plane of existence. The relationship is symbiotic, with each of us getting from the other what we need.


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Methods for Spells

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A Journey to Glastonbury

I spent nine days in Glastonbury in Somerset to explore the psychic and spiritual offerings it held. It was an unforgettable immersion at once into both the metaphysical and the palpable presence of other dimensions. My feeling was I had walked into the land of the fae; yet, also into the Neolithic world, though it had existed millennia before. I visited monoliths, walked across Bronze Age ground, climbed the Tor and saw the rain fill the valleys around it as if they were indeed the isle of Avalon.

I felt a change in the very air around me, as if I was walking in more than one world at once. Walking into a bookshop, I went into an alcove and found books and objects revealing the legends of the greenwood, the age of the Druids, the evocation of light and dark in a time before Christianity had come to Britain. In another shop, I walked amidst medieval fabrics and jewels, feeling an inexplicable link with it all.

In truth, I felt that link with everything I encountered in that place and its surroundings. Two years before, I had spent an hour alone in Stonehenge before dawn, courtesy of the English Heritage Society, and the one lone person outside the circle took photos. I touched every stone and it seemed as if I had become a part of the circle, belonging there, that somehow I was meant to see it.

In Glastonbury, the same thing happened when I was given a drive to Avebury and the avenues of the Neolithic creation that had been laid out six thousand years ago. And out my third floor window, in a bed & breakfast on Silver Street, I overlooked Glastonbury Abbey, often shrouded in mist. Its high gates appearing like sentinels over a landscape of stone ruins and history, and also, it was said, guarding the bones of Arthur and Guinevere.

These things changed me. I

understood all the times past are with us now in the same moment. We are meant to know this. There is no separation from the selves we have been and who we are now. All our many lives shape us and bring intense awareness, if we are open to this. We are touched by the merging of it

During those nine days in Glastonbury I had cream teas in perfect English shops with their flowers out front, so normal and predictable and lovely. Then I walked up the street to visit a psychic reader and time shifted again and I knew boundaries had dissolved between my life here and now and my life at other levels of being. It was not so much what the psychic reader told me as that I understood I had access on my own to such revelations, if I was willing to listen.

In my study, I have an 18-inch figure of Father Christmas, the ancient one with a crown of holly carrying a cloth bag of pine cones and forest branches and wearing a heavy coat lined with fur—it is not a modern

view—it comes from the merging of pagan and Christian with its return to the greenwood and its sense of winter and cold and journeying. I have carried this with me through twenty-one moves, for I find a continuity in the figure that is reassuring, and precious.

When we seek out the metaphysical deliberately, we can sometimes fool ourselves into thinking we can explain it. That is unlikely. It holds magic in it, and beauty, and legends, and contains our faith. It is there for us to experience.

But it is seldom there for us to know why it has affected us, or how.

That is the wonder of it all, and the mystery.

Spiritual Anarchy: Freedom of Self Expression

One of the greatest pleasures in life is free will, and the ability to exercise it to its fullest. Having independence and taking self-responsibility is one of the many ethical tenants that many witches adopt in their practices and daily life. There are many ways to practice, just as there are different types of witches and Pagans. One of the ways of practicing is what I like to refer to as spiritual anarchy.

Anarchy comes from the Greek word anarchos; "archos" meaning chief or leader, and "a" meaning without. Originally this meant governing one's self without a leader, or government interference. This is the definition that we'll use in this article.

What exactly does it mean to follow spiritual anarchy? How can you apply it into your daily practices? Since the phrase means to be spiritual without a leader, it is living a way of life free of dogma and rules

that normally come with religion and spiritual tenants. Spiritual anarchy is the freedom to completely practice, and believe, as you will. This does not mean that you are exempt from general laws and rules of science and the metaphysical, but that you are the navigator of your own destiny.

The simplest "rule" for starting your own practice is to delve into things you love. This includes 'mundane' activities such as hiking, art, and volunteer work whatever really brings your passion out. That's where you will find your center of power, as it opens the heart.

However, there are still consequences and truths that are unmoved by our vanity. Many practitioners have fallen into the trap that their belief can stop or bring about situations that go against the laws of nature and metaphysics. These laws still dispassionately exist and

happen without a human's permission. This is something to keep in mind, as spiritual anarchy focuses also on great self-responsibility.

Here are some simple suggestions that will make the transition into spiritual anarchy easier:

- Self Responsibility. This is probably the paramount "rule" that you need to be aware of regarding this practice. Every action and reaction is yours to own. You get to decide how to react when situations do not derive from yourself, too. This includes actively recognizing when you need to apologize and rectify a situation; and occasionally enact restitution. This may be hard because you must admit you were wrong, and correct your actions to the people you have affected.
- Integrity. It is very important to keep your word and follow through. There are times that illness and other

circumstances arise. In these cases, don't be afraid to give a brief explanation. Then, if you can, try to make up for it. If you are chronically ill, instead of making promises, explain that you will do your best but you can't guarantee anything due to health issues. Integrity also means that you don't lie, or spread rumors that are untrue. It is okay to talk out your feelings with trusted people, it is not okay to destroy another person's reputation based on false allegations.

• Learn Natural Laws. Natural laws are something that cannot be broken. For example, you cannot sprout wings and fly, but you can take a plane to get to a destination. There are similar laws when working with spirits and magic, which need to be followed in order to navigate the astral safely and effectively.


